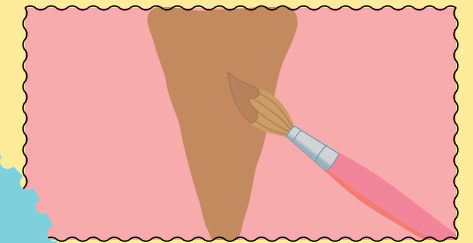

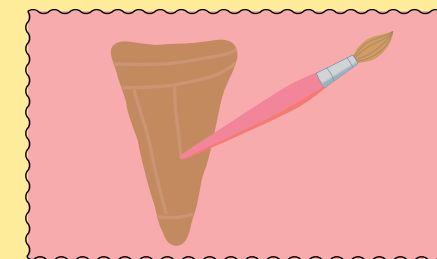
What you'll need

- ✦ Assortment of thick paints
- ✦ Cardboard
- ✦ Paintbrush
- ✦ Toothpick
- ✦ PVA glue
- ✦ Assorted seed and bugle beads
- ✦ Glitter

WHY NOT TRY...
...adapting the design to make some lollies, sundaes or any other favourite ice cream treats



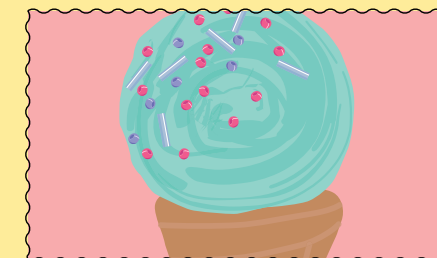
Step 1
Draw an ice cream shape on your cardboard and paint the cone part of it light brown.



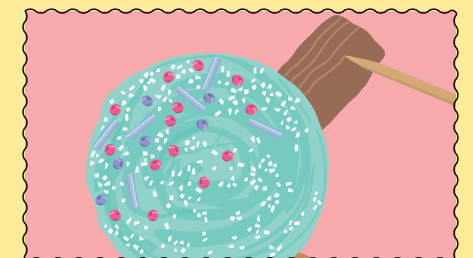
Step 2
With the paint still wet, use the other end of your brush to draw lines across the top, middle and base as shown.



Step 3
Mix white PVA glue with paint to make a thicker mixture to represent the ice cream. Paint a swirly circle on top.



Step 4
While the paint is still wet, scatter beads over the ice cream to create the effect of sugar sprinkles.



Step 5
Using dark brown paint, draw a flake sticking out of the ice cream, and use a toothpick to create its wavy lines.



Step 6
If you want to create a frosted look, sprinkle on a thin layer of glitter. You can then cut out your ice cream.
