

Seraquin Joint Supplement for Dogs Tablets

Dogs spend a great deal of time running. This means that the joints do indeed take a pounding. If your dog is very active, they may be exposed to injuries and joint-related problems. How do you know when your dog is not at his or her best? The best way to know is when there is a change of behavior. Depending on your dog, she may try to let you know, but some dogs may be stoic. Dogs do have a high tolerance for pain and may try to hide it as a survival instinct.

Some indicators of joint pain include limping, reluctance to get involved in strenuous activity like using the stairs, walking stiffly, getting up or down very slowly, changes in posture, whining, joint swelling, whimpering, unusual and excessive panting, frequently holding a leg off the ground, restlessness, favoring one leg or a change in sleeping patterns. If your dog is usually vocal, unusual quietness could be an indicator of pain. These symptoms will require a visit to the vet.

Treatment may range from supplements, anti-inflammatory drugs (steroidal and non-steroidal), narcotics, or use of a therapy laser. We will focus on the use of supplements. More precisely, the Seraquin Joint Supplement for Dogs Tablets.

An overview

Seraquin is a supplement that helps to support healthy joint function in dogs and keep injuries at bay. It is manufactured by Boehringer Ingelheim, a UK company that provides health products to animals and humans as well. The supplement can also be used in the treatment of cats. It comes in form of a tablet that your pet can chew. You can also crush it into food. The supplement is available as a 2g or 800 mg tablet for smaller dogs. It is supplied in packs of 60 or 360.

Ingredients

Seraquin joint supplement for dogs tablets are made up of two main ingredients: chondroitin and glucosamine. These ingredients are naturally found within the dog's body but their production reduces as the dog grows older. The joints are therefore prone to wear and tear, becoming painful. Your pet is more likely to benefit from this supplement if they are older. The other ingredient in Seraquin is curcuminoids. These are natural antioxidants that have anti-inflammatory effects.

Dosage

In the beginning, you need to give your dog a loading dose for about 4 to 6 weeks. The dosage is then dropped gradually until you get to the maintenance dose. You need to follow your vet's prescription.

Pros

Side effects

Seraquin is a safe product. If used correctly, it has no serious side effects. Its safety has not been tested on pregnant or nursing dogs. Your dog should not be allergic to corn protein (an inactive ingredient). If your dog has diabetes, clotting disorders, hyperglycemia, sea fish allergies and urinary tract stones consult with your vet before using Seraquin.
