ince Richard Curtis's Four Weddings and a Funeral was etched into pop cultural lore, we have come to associate village churches, awkward party line-ups, illconceived table plans and the 'meringue' as clichéd hallmarks of the quintessential English wedding. But times have changed. These days, couples are tossing aside the rulebook for something less formulaic (and more fun).

'The proliferation of wedding blogs alongside social media platforms Pinterest, Instagram et al. have inspired a new generation of couples to flex their creative muscles,' says Penelope Cullen of Tigerlily Weddings in Clapham (tigerlilyweddings.co.uk), whose services include full or partial planning, advice and tailor-made concierge services to suit a range of budgets. 'Today's couples are more confident about what they want, to

celebrate their day, their way.'

Marquees offer elegant convenience, but now there's a penchant for edgier venues that add a pop of character to proceedings. Maverick Projects and Castle Gibson, trendy among the art crowd for exhibitions and shoots, offer a

variety of urban studio spaces for wedding hire. 'Ten years ago a dilapidated warehouse would be unthinkable for exchanging vows, but today anything goes,' says Cullen.

Likewise, no longer does the bride necessarily have the monopoly. 'It's refreshing to see more grooms involved in the planning process – be it the music, bar, food or all of the above. It's really become a team effort.'

First things first, we recommend you enlist Gee Brothers (printers of fine bespoke stationary) to craft the perfect wedding invitations. When it comes to catering, the predictable three-course meat and two veg mainstay has given way to more sociable dining. Inventive



> becoming popular. Informal street food stalls and barbeque for late night revelers are other options available for those looking for creative, cost-effective cuisine. 'A wedding should flow, and there are so many more festive options available to complement or even replace







Tim Birks of Birksen Flowers in Clapham Old Town (birksen.com) echoes similar themes. 'We're seeing less demand for neat, manicured arrangements in favour of more intimate, homespun charm – mixing different flowers, textures and theatrical props for a whimsical feel.' Think more backyard bohemian than polished perfection.

On the fashion front, the stiff and starchy lace of yesteryear's bridal wear has given way to a sleeker silhouette. 'Every bride wants to stand out on her wedding day,' posits Luella's Bridal boutique in Wimbledon (luellas.co.uk), which offers a considered edit of original, vintage-inspired bridal wear and accessories exclusive to the boutique, including Limor Rosen, Vicky Rowe, Kite & Butterfly and Luella's own label. Not a whalebone corset or whipped-up meringue in sight.



Where fashion goes, hair and makeup follow. 'We're seeing high demand for "undone" up-dos and romantic plaits,' says celebrity makeup artist and stylist Charlotte Cave (charlottecave.com), who also advises brides avoid make-up trends and stay true to their natural style.

Whatever the fashion, every bride wants to look and feel her absolute best (some things never change).

Although The Gardens are open to the public on select days, with a lot going into making them accessible for young and old, it's clear that a stand out feature is the fact it's the ultimate romantic English country idyll to make a wedding extra special.
