REGIONAL COORDINATOR AND ADVISOR - GREEN ECONOMIES

World Wildlife Fund for Nature - Cambodia (2014 -2016)

- Successfully implemented a three-year regional green economy initiative for the WWF across the Greater Mekong Region;
- This included the delivery of technical, strategic and communications advice across all 5 national WWF offices as well as to other relevant national and regional stakeholders on green economy related themes;
- Achievements: increased availability of green economy information, data and guidelines and communications strategies and outputs as well as enhanced policies at the national level especially in Cambodia and Myanmar, expansion of green economy activities across the region as well as increased positive behaviour change among stakeholders.

SENIOR ADVISOR - KNOWLEDGE GENERATION

United Nations Environment Programme - Switzerland (2011 - 2012)

- Invited to join the UNEP TEEB (The Economics of Ecosystem and Biodiversity) Office to advise on the knowledge generation behind their key training activities both online and in person;
- Thanks to these efforts over 10 countries have now executed ecosystem valuation studies at the national level and have incorporated natural capital values into their national accounting systems. Ecosystem services are also now much more mainstreamed in environmentally policy making at the global level.

WRITER & RESEARCHER ON BIODIVERSITY FINANCING, ENVIRONMENTAL GOVERNANCE, CLIMATE CHANGE AND FOOD SECURITY

Various organisations (2007-2014)

- **European Commission:** Executed an internal assessment of non-ODA financing flows for biodiversity projects from the EU to developing countries. The study has enabled the EU to identify new sources of biodiversity financing.
- **World Conservation Union (IUCN):** Led several biodiversity financing and environmental governance processes at their HQ in Switzerland and for their Mesoamerican offices, thanks to repeat hire. The outcomes have been wide reaching including the conceptualization of a regional transboundary conservation project in Central America, the development of the first publication on International Payments for Ecosystem Services, and research towards improved governance structures of IUCNs Independent Scientific Review Panel surrounding the conservation of Western Gray Whales.
- **Global Alliance for Improved Nutrition (GAIN):** Co-authored and researched a background paper on the impacts of climate change on global nutritional security which was used to inform speaking points for the Director of Gain at UNFCCC COP 2011 in Durban and to help position them in global climate change debates. GAIN now mainstreams climate change throughout their programmes.
- **UNEP-Chemicals:** Led the proposal writing of a successfully funded medium sized GEF project (US\$1 million). The project, which was funded in 2011, aims to reduce the local and global environmental risks from mercury mining in Kyrgyzstan.
- **UNEP – Economics & Trade Branch:** Co-authored a discussion paper on international biodiversity offsets which was presented at a Biodiversity and Business Offset Program meeting in Rome in 2008. This work forms the basis of the Verified Conservation Areas initiative.
