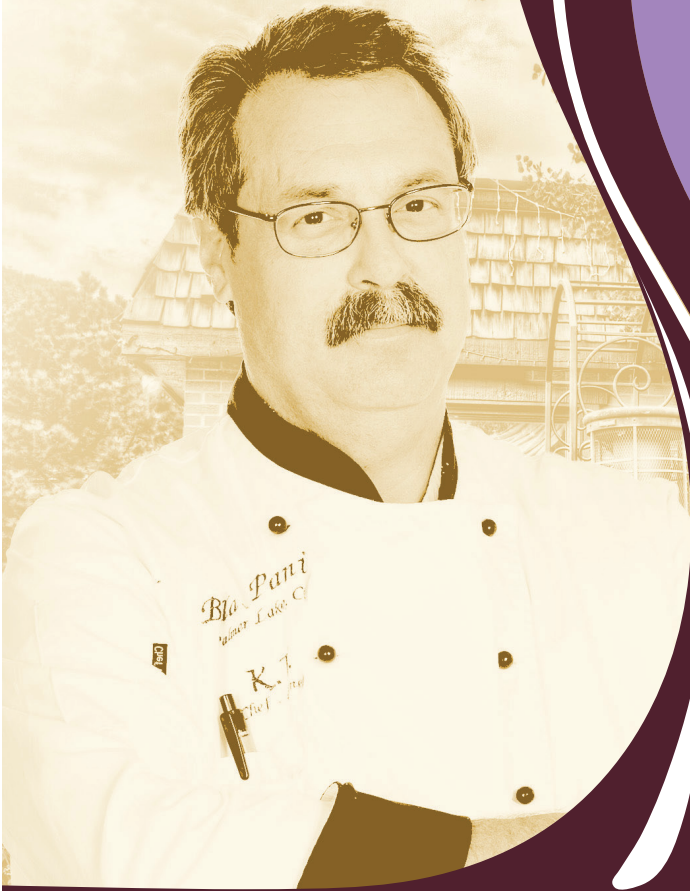

Ambassador's Story **BART, ROZI & AUSTIN GOULD**

*A*fter several years of marriage and successfully navigating careers in the Air Force, Bart and Rozalyn (Rozi) Gould decided it was time to expand their family and were thrilled at the promise of a new baby.

The pregnancy was progressing smoothly until their world came crashing at 26 weeks, when Rozi went into premature labor. She spent the next eight weeks in the hospital on bed rest, doing everything possible to help her tiny baby grow. One treatment the baby received was surfactant, a therapy developed with help from March of Dimes grantees, to develop his lungs. During this difficult time, Bart and Rozi were stationed in Utah, far away from their family, but were fortunate to receive their support when they visited throughout the duration of the pregnancy.

When Rozi was 34.5 weeks pregnant, doctors decided that the risk of infection was too high to continue the pregnancy any longer, and Austin was delivered, weighing just over five pounds. Austin spent time in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), but was soon able to go home with his parents. At 17 months, after noticing that Austin was not reaching his developmental milestone, the Goulds found out

that Austin had a chromosomal abnormality, Inverted Deleted Duplication of 8P.

Today, Austin is a thriving three-year-old, doted on by both his parents.

The Gould family is serving as the 2015 Colorado Signature Chefs Auction Ambassador Family to help raise awareness about the lifesaving research and support of the March of Dimes. They are committed to helping other families avoid the heart ache of preterm birth.

Bart and Rozi credit the March of Dimes with helping Austin thrive by funding research and other programs that help premature or sick babies. They are now expecting their second baby, and want to ask other families to join them in supporting the March for Babies.

“Every single day that the March of Dimes is out there doing what they do, it improves the lives of someone,” said Bart.

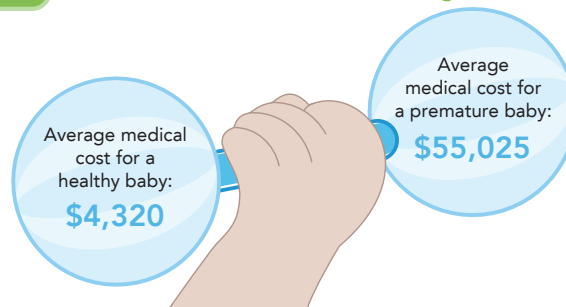

Almost every baby receives a **polio vaccine** developed with funding by the March of Dimes. Children in El Paso County are vaccinated against **14** diseases.

Surfactant therapy, developed with funding from the March of Dimes, saves the lives of thousands of babies each year whose lungs are not fully developed.

Babies in El Paso County receive screening for **30** inherited disorders. We funded the development of **4** of these tests and advocated for **newborn screening** for all babies.

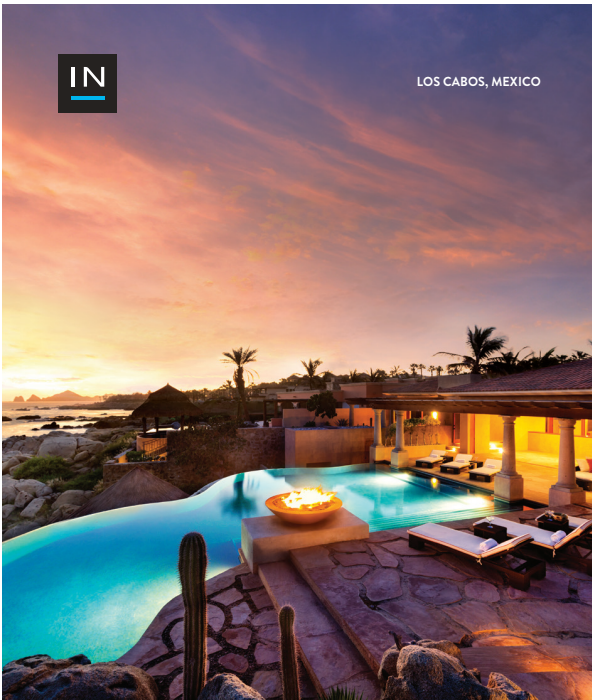

One in 10 Colorado babies is born too soon.

March of Dimes is dedicated to improving the health of every baby by reducing birth defects, premature birth and infant loss. Colorado's preterm birth rate has improved by 15% since 2006, saving nearly 6,700 babies and saving approximately \$196 million in healthcare costs.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Through grant funding, March of Dimes partners with community organizations across Colorado so that more women receive quality prenatal education and care.

ADVOCACY

In 2014, we held two legislative events at the state capitol. We had three bills pass as wins for moms and babies. We also launched an advocacy leadership course.

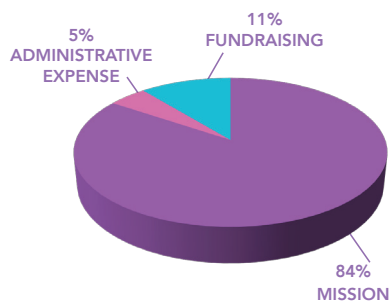
We've created of a network of five research centers for the study of multiple aspects of pregnancy and premature birth. Since 2004, we have funded more than \$4 million in Colorado research.

EDUCATION

Through our programs including Healthy Babies Healthy Business, 12-Month Pregnancy, choose4two, and Mission: Healthy Baby, we bring information to healthcare providers and families.

SUPPORT

Through our Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) Family Support programs, we serve about 2,000 Colorado families a year.



In Colorado, 84 cents of every dollar funds mission programs.
