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I. POSSESSOR OF THE BALL

Possessor of the ball

* Vocab

- To drive (conducir) = to carry the ball forward from one zone to another
- To dribble (regatear) = to work through a tight space, keeping the ball by using technique and body movements to avoid opponents

Progress
Progress vertically by "driving," "dribbling," or passing (over the top or on the ground)

Attract opponents to create space
Retain the ball, "drive" it, or play with nearby ~~opponents~~ teammates with the objective of pulling opponents towards you to create space elsewhere or "free up" teammates.

Play horizontally
"Drive," dribble, or pass horizontally when faced with the inability to progress vertically, looking to keep possession of the ball and create spaces to progress vertically.

Restart the play
When faced with the inability to progress, play backwards to a teammate in support in order to avoid losing the ball and restart the play

Finish
Look to attack the opponent's goal.

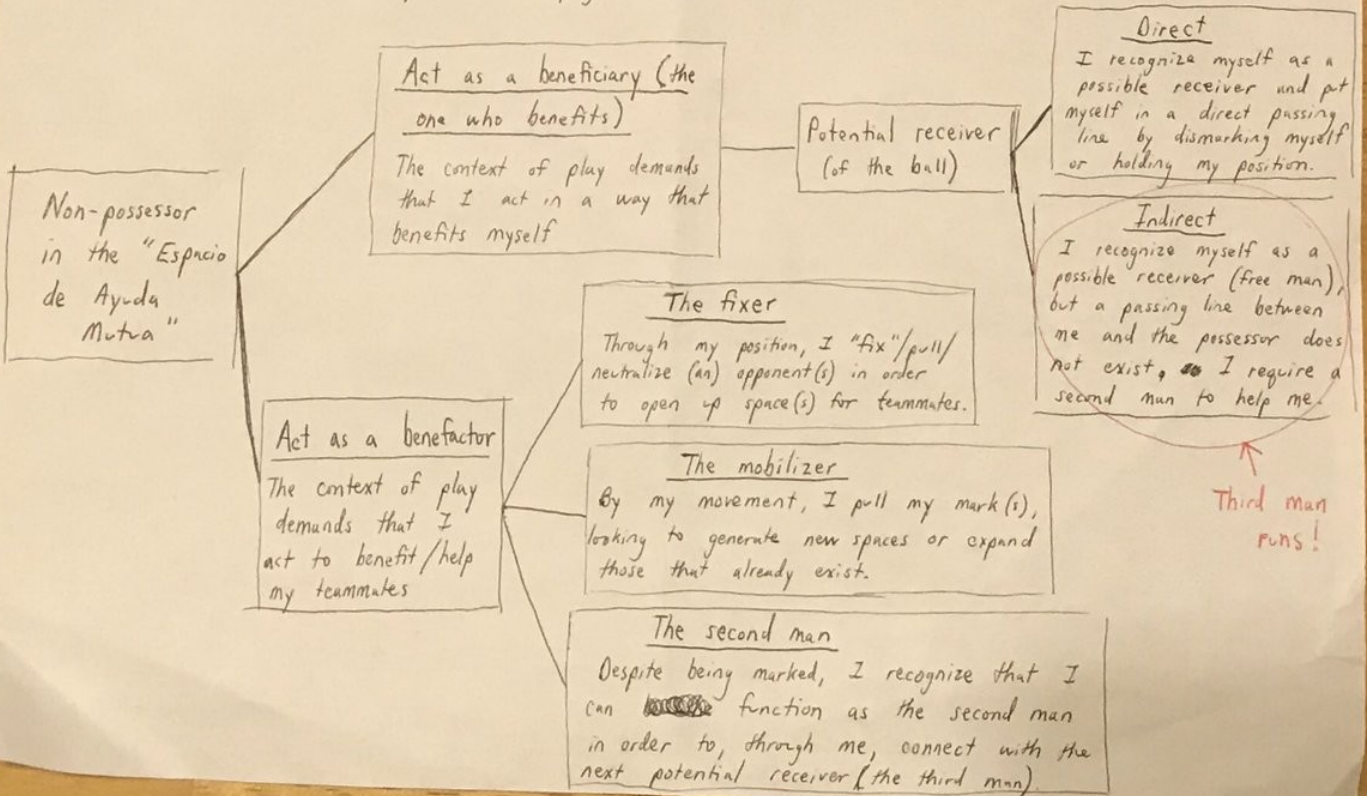
Vocab

- par = even, as in "mark" because $1+1=2$
- impar = odd / uneven, as in 2v1 or 1v2

* Espacio de ayuda mutua = a space where the possessor of the ball and (a) teammate(s) can help or mutually benefit each other by making certain decisions.

- ayuda mutua = "common help" AKA helping teammates

II. Attacker without the ball in the "espacio de ayuda mutua" (active zone)



Vocab

• Los espacios de fase (phase spaces): The space in which all possible states (phases) of a system are / can be represented.

- ① The space of mutual help: A player in this zone is relatively close to the ball and eligible to participate.
- ② The space of intervention: This space exists within the space of mutual help. A player who was eligible to participate enters this space when he actually intervenes, or involves himself in the play.
- ③ The space of cooperation: Players in this space may be disconnected from the ball, but they still maintain their positions in order to help the team keep its shape and create space & opportunities for players in other zones.

III. Attacker without the ball in the space of cooperation (disconnected/remote)

Non-possessor in the space of cooperation

Intervene in the center of play

If the action requires it, I will put myself ~~inside~~ inside the "center of play" in order to adopt any of the possible roles of a non-possessing player in the space of mutual help.

Occupation of potentially useful spaces

Trying to anticipate the upcoming actions, I put myself in a good position to see them through.

Prepare for the loss (of ball)

When I detect that I cannot be useful at an offensive level, my objective will be to prepare for the future defensive transition of my team.

Offensive surveillance

Watch or mark unmarked opponents in order to avoid or make difficult the counter attack

Provide balance

Occupy rationally the spaces disconnected from the ball (width & depth), giving to the team a good structure that facilitates the defensive transition
