

MATTE MAGIC

Caesarstone, makers of quality quartz surfaces, introduced four new colours for 2018, of which the matte Excava surface in the new Metropolitan Collection caught our eye.



aesarstone, which has been creating quartz surfaces for more than 30 years, recently introduced new weathered patinas in its Metropolitan Collection of concrete-inspired surfaces, of which one in particular stood out for the VISI team at Decorex Cape Town 2018 earlier this year: Excava 4046.

The 20 mm-thick Excava surface has a matte finish, but it is just as durable and non-porous as Caesarstone's polished surfaces. Weathered patinas, which are new to the quartz industry, are a signature feature in the collection, with

Excava reflecting the aesthetics and textures associated with oxidised steel, polished copper and hammered brass. Suitable for use in kitchens and bathrooms, Excava will complement vivid block colour and contrasting materials like smoked glass and wood.

The other two new colours in the brand's industrial-look Metropolitan Collection are Airy Concrete 4044 and Cloudburst Concrete 4011.

Like all Caesarstone surfaces, Excava comes with a lifetime warranty.
