

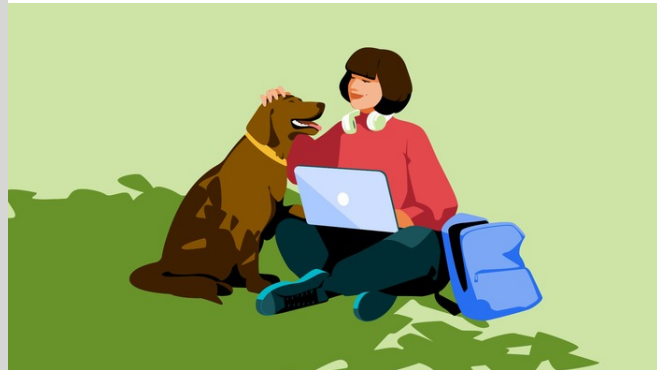

A student's perspective on the impact of AI

About 86% of college students use AI on a weekly, if not daily basis, says a recent digital survey. Alongside this, business professionals are having to use AI more regularly with workflows integrating new features, such as Gemini Pro's built-in abilities in Google Sheets and even prompt-generated PowerPoints.

So what's the difference between using AI and participating in the testing of AI? Sabrina Zabalaga, a student ambassador and junior at USF, says there's a big difference.

"It's so versatile," she says, "and I think that's what kind of drew me in. On the platform, I was able to select which skill sets I have, whether that was, like, translation or data labeling or coding, and I got to reflect on and apply my specific skill sets to different projects. I think it was being able to build my skill sets, but specifically to my discipline, in a hands-on environment."



Journeying beyond

Not only did Sabrina have the opportunity to explore her skill sets, but she also found the process of self-evaluation beneficial.

"I am definitely getting a better understanding of my skill sets, like coding, data analysis, and data labeling, by getting hands-on experience doing projects. Maybe it's to enhance this code, edit another code, or just improve it in some type of way. I'm gaining a better understanding of how that might work."

Thanks to Sabrina, students from a wide range of disciplines are getting involved in Uber AI Solutions projects through Handshake.

Recently, over 3,000 students from all over the US expressed interest in a project that ran for 8 days as a short data labeling sprint. Overall, students made up 63% of participants, underscoring the scale, enthusiasm, and value students bring to these projects. Opportunities like this provide students with a place to build practical skills such as time management and critical evaluation alongside their academic coursework.
