Getting Back on Track

Why FAST?

- › Sometimes families are overwhelmed with the commitment an online school requires.
- › FAST supports students and their families when a student's success in school is negatively impacted by their attendance and incomplete school work.



What is Daily Attendance?

Daily attendance is a combination of two factors:

1. Students must be actively engaged in school on school days, following the official school calendar.

AND

2. Students must complete and submit work as assigned by their teachers.





FAST GOALS

- › Work with the student and family to identify and understand the obstacles to school success
- › Work with the student, family, and teacher to develop an appropriate and doable Back on Track Plan (BOT)
- › Meet/Communicate with family and teacher each week to monitor progress on BOT
- › Support efforts to meet BOT requirements and recommend suggestions for success
- › Move student and family out of FAST when compliant with attendance and current with school work

The Big Picture

Attendance is credited to students based upon work completed in combination with daily attendance on school days.

Both of these attendance requirements must be met each day for attendance to be marked.



Next Steps

- › Creation of a BOT plan with Teacher, Learning Coach and Student in agreement
- › Meet again in 1 week to go over progress
- › Monitor progress and successfully get back on track with school
