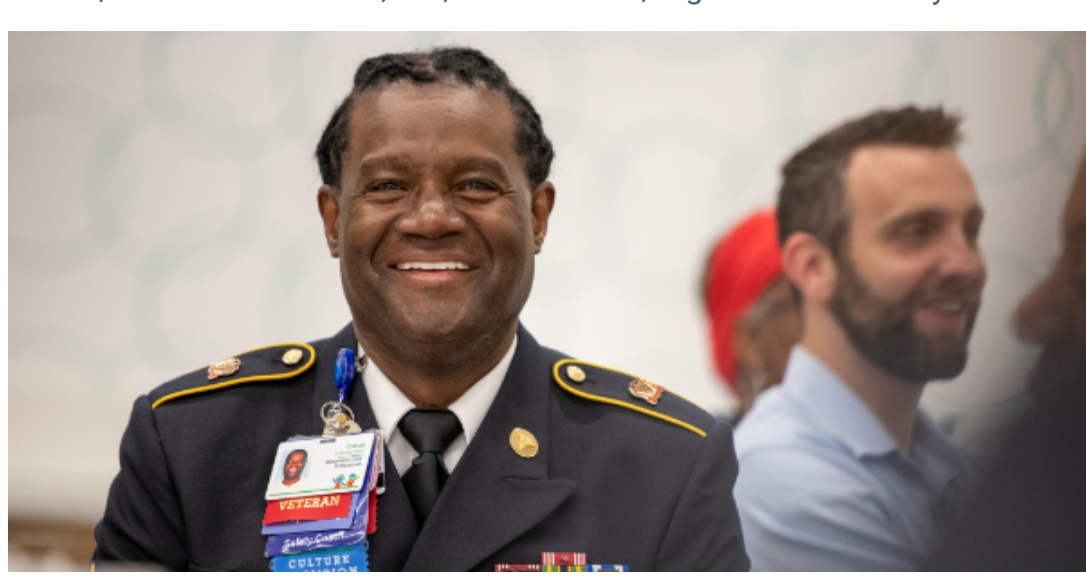
Opportunity and Growth Matter: New Career Center Helps Our Team Pursue New Paths to Job Fulfillment at Children's
