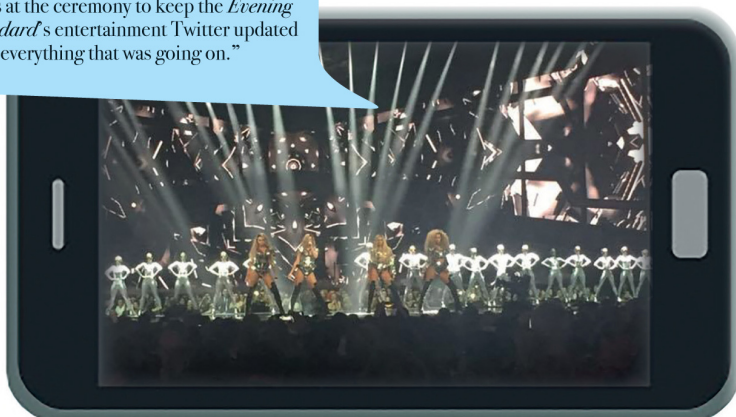
Jonathan Haynes, technology editor, *The Guardian*

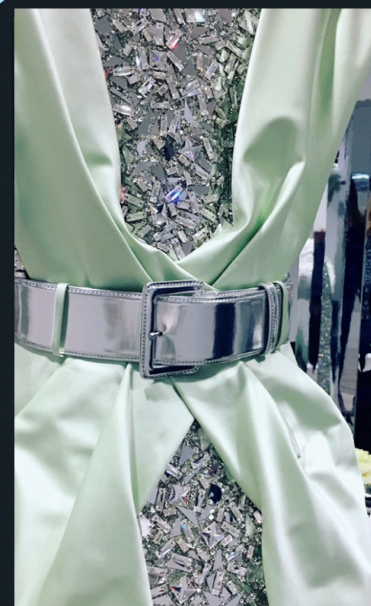


Mark Russell, managing editor, British GQ and GQ Style

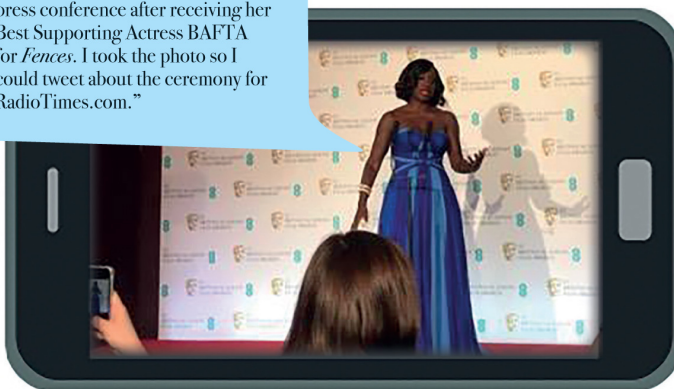
Lucy Kebbell, fashion assistant, Harper's Bazaar and Town & Country

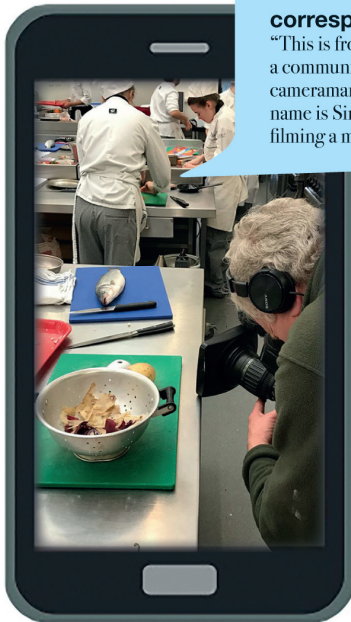
