The Neuroendocrine Tumor Research Foundation (NETRF) is the largest private funder of neuroendocrine tumor (NET) research. We are dedicated to funding research to discover cures and more effective treatments for neuroendocrine cancers. NETRF also works to improve the lives of patients, caregivers, and families living with neuroendocrine tumors by providing them with resources to educate and empower them in their journey.

AN UNCOMMON AND UNDERFUNDED CANCER

NETs are an overlooked, misunderstood cancer type that forms in neuroendocrine cells and are found in many different organs.

NET research is underfunded. It accounts for only **.125%** of government-funded grants. However, based on the prevalence of NETs in the U.S. population, NETs should receive **5 times** more funding. NETRF bridges this gap and has advanced the understanding of NET biology and treatment by funding nearly **30%** of all NET research.

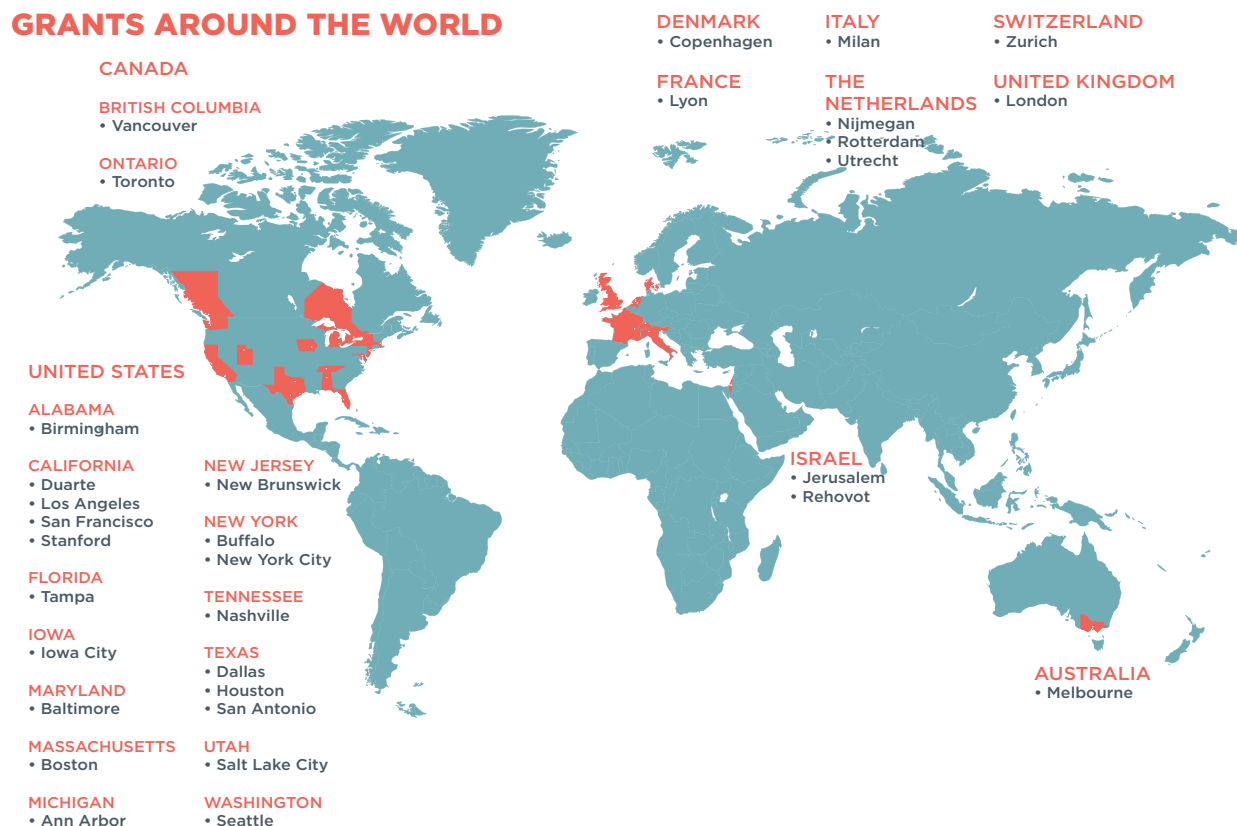
15 YEARS OF NETRF SUCCESS, 2005-2020
