Dr. Bhavani Chillara and Dr. Laura Lindholm of CHPG Women's Health cared for his mother through a difficult pregnancy and delivery. Three months before Kane's due date, his mother was diagnosed with gestational diabetes. She spent three days in the birth center with contractions waiting for active labor to start.

"I was given a choice. Dr. Chillara could break my water or I could come back in a few days. I wasn't leaving without my baby, so I chose to have my water broken and that's when the real contractions started. I went into this knowing I could possibly have a C-section because of the gestational diabetes, so I wasn't dead set on a natural birth, but it was nerve wracking. I was started to have anxiety, but then I made a connection with Dr. Laura Lindholm, also a former Texan. She let me know throughout the surgery that everything was going well.
