- Had your first menstrual period before age 12
- Have no children or had your first child at age 35 or later
- Entered menopause after age 55
- Have dense breast tissue
- Have received hormone therapy for five years or more
- Have had multiple breast biopsies

- Have had a breast biopsy showing atypical cells
- Have previously had breast cancer
- Have had radiation treatment of the chest area
- Have a mother, sister, paternal aunt or grandmother diagnosed with breast cancer at any age

Your family members or you may face a higher risk of breast cancer if:

- A blood family member was diagnosed with breast cancer before age 50
- A blood male family member was diagnosed with breast cancer at any age
- Multiple family members were diagnosed with breast cancer
- You are of Ashkenazi Jewish heritage
- A blood family member was diagnosed with ovarian cancer
- You or a family member had triple negative breast cancer
- You or a family member had breast cancer and pancreatic cancer
