
From viral hitmaker to award-winning leading man,

Berkeley's Andy Samberg continues to cement his place as a Hollywood heavyweight. By LeeAnne Jones



The first time Andy Samberg hosted a major awards show, the 2009 MTV Movie Awards, he was beamed from the USS *Enterprise* into Justin Timberlake's limo—naked. Four years later, in his opening monologue at the Film Independent Spirit Awards, he unleashed a giddy, expletive-laden tirade against Hollywood.

It's really anyone's guess what kind of envelopepushing antics the Berkeley native will employ when he hosts the 67th Primetime Emmy Awards this month but it's bound to be memorable. And the gig is a nice feather in the cap for a comedian whose star has been steadily on the rise.

Samberg got his big break in 2005, when Saturday Night Live scooped up The Lonely Island, the comedy troupe he formed with fellow Berkeley High classmates Akiva Schaffer and Jorma Taccone. As a writer and performer with SNL for seven seasons, most memorably with pop culture–skewering music videos, Samberg earned six Emmy nominations and one win (for the song "Dick in a Box" with Timberlake).

In a 2007 *Diablo* profile, Samberg said, "The movies that Adam Sandler did that came out during my junior high and high school years were pivotal for me in letting me know I can do comedy." Fittingly, since 2012, Samberg has been on a post–*SNL* trajectory similar to that of his comedy hero: big-budget comedies (*That's My Boy*), indie charmers (*Celeste and Jesse Forever*), animation voiceovers (*Hotel Transylvania*), and a handful of cameos. Soon though, we predict he'll manage to eclipse Sandler.

In 2013, Samberg returned to television as lovably goofy detective Jake Peralta on the cop comedy *Brooklyn Nine-Nine*—and he even brought in Sandler for a guest role. The show earned a Golden Globe Award, as did Samberg for best comedic actor in a TV series. Also scoring major awards attention last year was the song "Everything Is Awesome," from *The LEGO® Movie*, which received Grammy and Oscar nominations. (The Lonely Island rapped on the song.) This past summer, Samberg had another critical hit, starring in HBO's over-the-top tennis mockumentary, *7 Days in Hell*, which was written and produced by Samberg's long-time friend (and Alamo native) Murray Miller.

The year ahead looks to be even bigger. In addition to the release of *Hotel Transylvania 2* on September 25 and the return of *Brooklyn Nine-Nine* on September 27, Samberg will appear with The Lonely Island in the summer movie *Connor4real*, a riff on pop-concert films about boy bands, coproduced by Judd Apatow. And of course, there's the Emmys.
