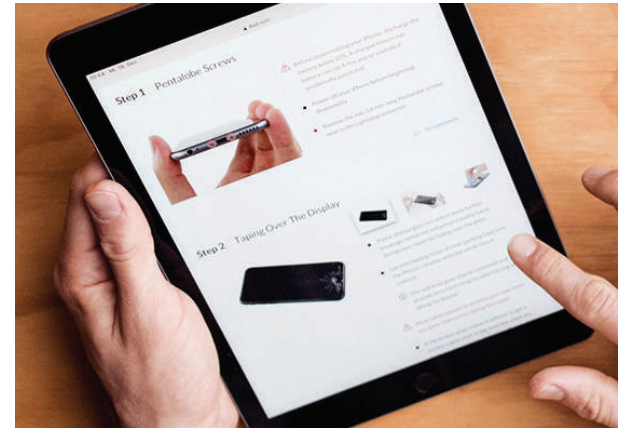

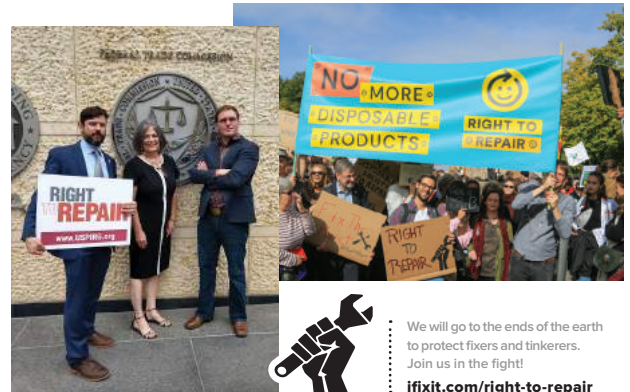

As you might expect from engineering students, they decided to open it up and try to fix it the hard way: by themselves.

Luke and Kyle posted their repair process online, and they kept posting more repairs—until iFixit had more Apple repair information than anywhere else on the internet. Then, they open sourced their guides and invited the community to help them write a repair guide for every thing. Now, iFixit is the global leader in repair.
