

## **OSRS Fremennik Easy Diary Guide**

Fremennik is a collection of achievement journals centered on the Fremennik Province. Here is a guide on how to complete the Fremennik Easy Diary. The Fremennik Diary is a collection of achievement diaries published on the 5th of March, 2015. There are 4 distinct difficulty levels - Easy, Medium, Hard, and Elite - each with its own set of prizes and criteria.

Players will require the metrics displayed in the infobox to the right to accomplish all of the objectives. Unless otherwise specified, temporary skill enhancements apply to all diary tasks.

Players may claim their awards from Thorodin, which is located outside of Rellekka. Players must complete a previous tier's diaries to claim benefits from the subsequent level (For example, players must accomplish the Easy and Medium Level to claim awards from the Hard Level)

### **How to Start:**

To begin, select Fremennik by clicking the green star on the upper right side of your quest screen.

### **Quests Required:**

- The Fremmenik Trials
- Wolf Whistle
- Death Plateau
- The Giant Dwarf
- Troll Stronghold

### **Skills Required:**

- 5 Thieving
- 23 Crafting
- 11 Hunter
- 20 Mining
- 20 Smithing
- 15 Firemaking
- 15 Woodcutting
- 10 Slayer

### **Items Required:**

- Weapon

- Armor
- Food
- Fishing Utensils (Rod & Bait, Harpoon)
- Summoning Pouch
- Bird Snare
- 500 coins
- Bucket
- Climbing Boots
- Tinderbox
- Tiara Mould

### Tasks to Complete Fremennik Easy Diary

1. On the northern Ice Plains, locate the **Hunting Expert**. The Hunting Expert is located on a small, frozen peninsula north of the Rock Crabs.
2. **Slay 5 Rock Crabs** on the shore near Rellekka or Waterbirth Island. Rock crabs can be found on Rellekka's northeastern coast, both inside and outside the gates.
3. **Catch the cerulean twitch** (A bluebird). You are required to use your hunter skills which were aforementioned before.
4. **Craft a tiara in Rellekka**. Using any pickaxe, mine silver ore from the Rellekka mine on the east side of town and use the furnace. (You are required to complete the Fremennik Trials and have Smithing, Crafting and Mining Skills)
5. At the Rellekka well, **fill the bucket with water**.
6. **Collect 5 Snapegrass** found on Waterbirth Island (One way to travel is to speak with Jarvald in Rellekka. You can drop and collect a single piece of snape grass five times, though they spawn very close together)
7. **Catch a fish from Rellekka's piers**. There are various fishing sites, so bring your Rod & Bait, Harpoon, or Net.
8. **Change your boots** which you can do Yrsa's Shoe Store. (Talk with Yrsa about having a makeover first, and then browse her usual apparel store to complete this job. Additionally, as with most tasks, you will be unable to complete this task if you have begun but not finished The Fremennik Trials)

9. In the Fremennik Province, **chop and burn some oak wood**. (Oak woods are discovered near the home portal)

10. Otto Godblessed's peak to barbarian training. **Consult Otto Godblessed for information** on Firemaking and other barbarian skills. This is best done after interacting with Captain Cain, as they are pretty near one another.

11. **Steal from Baker's Stall or Keldagrim Crafting** (5 Thievery Skills is required, and you should have begun The Giant Dwarf.)

**Rewards:**

- Seaboats Fremennik 1
- Each day, 1 free teleport to Rellekka will be provided.
- 1 antique lamp worth 2,500 experience in any skill above 30 will be provided.
- Peer the Seer will serve as a bank deposit box.
- When you make a sacrifice, Fossegrimen will charge your enchanted lyre.

The **Easy Diaries** grant you one free teleport to Rellekka every day, which can be rather handy in some instances if you wish to visit Rock Crabs or are required to visit Rellekka for a Quest.

However, the greatest rewards are found in the Hard Fremennik Diaries. Hard grants you access to 2 new Lunar Spells. The Tan Leather Spell, which can generate approximately 800,000 coins and 120,000 Magic XP per hour.

The Recharge Dragonstone, which, in some instances, can be rather profitable. Another aspect of the Hard Diaries is that the Aviansies in the Godwars Dungeon which drops Marked Adamant Bars rather than Unmarked Adamant Bars. This makes them extremely profitable, as they frequently drop them in stacks of four.

The Elite Diaries cause the Dagannoth Kings to drop Dagannoth Bones, which makes them extremely profitable at around 10,000 per bone.
