

Trip Highlights

- Step aboard your Zodiac craft to get close to wonders off Antarctica's shores, including Weddell seals on ice floes, skua seabirds wheeling overhead, and massive white-blue icebergs in a fantastic array of shapes.
- Walk in the footsteps of Ernest Shackleton and the other bold explorers from the Heroic Age of Antarctic Exploration when you first step upon the seventh continent.
- Meet one of Antarctica's friendly locals—the penguin. Watch as they waddle about, slide down hills on their bellies, and gather stones for their nests.



Itinerary Summary

Physical Requirements

- Walk 3 miles unassisted on uneven terrain and participate in 6-8 hours of activities each day,
- Good agility, balance, and strength are needed for this expedition.
 Unlike traditional cruises, you will board Zodiac boats daily.
- Experience a Drake Passage crossing over the course of 4 days where rough seas and constant ship motion are common




Physical Requirements (cont.)

- We require medical forms be signed and stamped by a doctor, as well as medical coverage and emergency evacuation coverage of at least \$500,000 each.
- Travelers will be a two-day distance from the nearest medical facility.

 Those using mobility aids or with medical conditions that may require immediate attention or evacuation will not be able to board.
