The Green Mountain Dairy Farm gives milk to the St Albans Cooperative Creamery often. They have 1,500 acres that goes through Sheldon, Highgate, Swanton, & St Albans and they are growing a plethora of corn & hay. Their business was well-planned out from the beginning so they have gained accolades.

They set plenty of goals & accomplished those. They overcame obstacles & kept going strong. In 2007, they started using a methane digester to keep their dairy farm lit up with electricity which brings about 1.8 kilowatts of power every year. They're linked with the CVPS Cow Power. They do care about ecology so they found a way to use the company Ben & Jerry's waste water in the Green Mountain Dairy Farm's digester.

Some of Their Accomplishments

In 2008, they retrieved the accolade Vermont Dairy of the Year. In 2015, they shipped 27 million pounds of lots of the terrific milk because their dairy's master-key focus is very top quality. A plethora of people got an invitation to their farmhouse for breakfast vittles in the year 2016. In April 2020, Green Mountain Dairy received a Paycheck Protection Program loan in the amount of \$178,262 to keep 26 employees on their staff.
