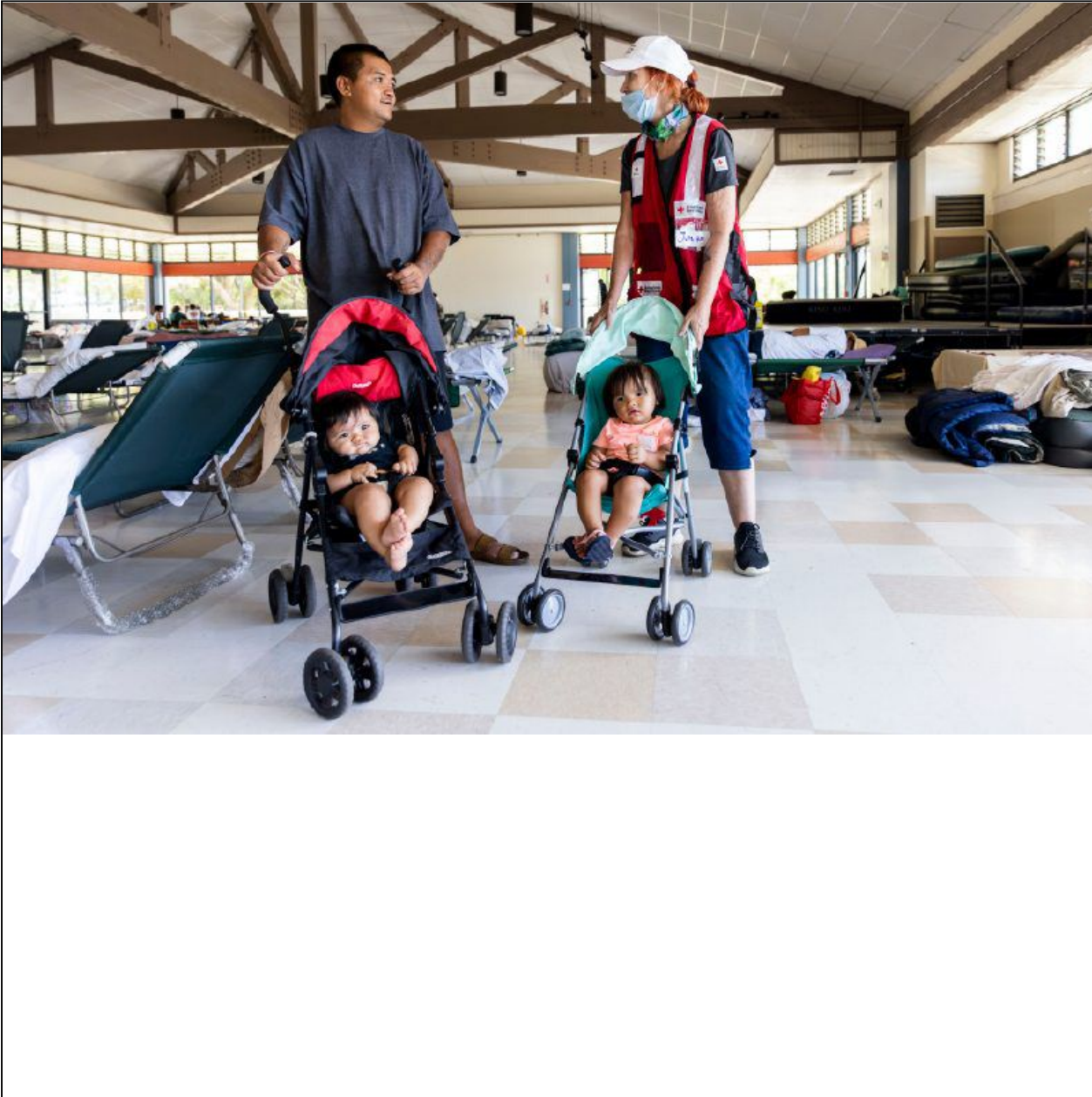

As Daniel and his family escaped the deadly fire that consumed Lahaina, he risked his life, running into burning homes to save others, most of whom were elderly.  
"Growing up here in Hawaii, you always think about taking care of the older generation first," Daniel said. "We always take care of the Kapuna, the elderly. So, that was my drive. I'm not going to let these elderly people die. They could be somebody else's grandparents. I have no grandparents. So, I rushed in and saved the elderly people."
