



# Plan Your Trip

## GROUP LEADER AND CHAPERONES

Select a group leader to serve as the contact with the reservations office, prepare group members and complete and return all trip paperwork and payments. Chaperones are expected to participate in all group activities, supervise the group to assure safety and monitor the group's free time.

## LEARNING CENTER STAFF

Learning Center staff, including volunteers, facilitate all programs. Our volunteers come from around the world and range from age 18 to retirees. A thorough background check is required for all team members.

## WEATHER AND PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

Programs are held rain or shine. For outdoor programs, if weather conditions are dangerous, groups will stay in a weather-safe area. Though programs are not too physically challenging, all group members should be prepared for moderate amounts of walking.

## MEALS AND LODGING

**Heifer Ranch:** Meals and lodging are included in all overnight program fees. All special dietary needs must be prearranged prior to arrival. Lodging for nights not spent in the Global Village is determined by your program.

**Heifer Village:** Café@Heifer serves lunch Monday through Friday. Sack lunches are also available. Orders must be made a minimum of one week in advance. Cancellation fees may apply. Call for current menu and prices.

Both Heifer Ranch and Heifer Village feature a Shop@Heifer, offering globally-themed books, Heifer logo merchandise and other unique items that encourage others to support Heifer's work.

## RESERVATIONS AND RATES

Heifer Village offers programs year-round (excluding major holidays). Programs last approximately one to two hours. For proper planning, group leaders should book at least two weeks in advance. Visit [www.heifer.org/village](http://www.heifer.org/village) for more program information.

READ TO FEED®

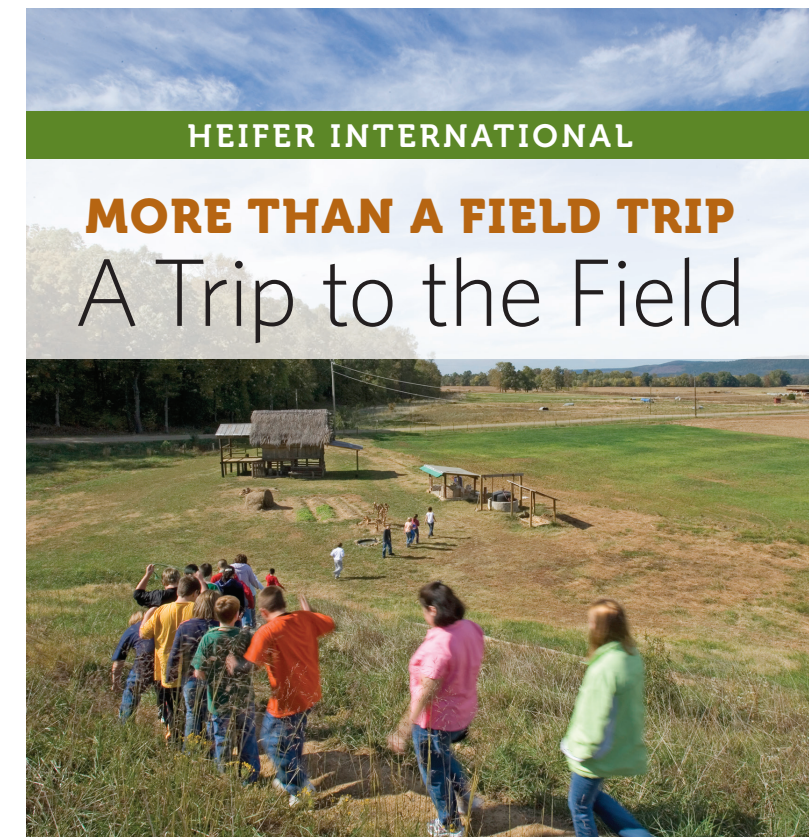
Engage your students before and after your visit with Read to Feed®. Beforehand, you can prepare your students with our standards-based lessons about hunger and poverty. Our global education lesson plans will help provide students with knowledge that allow them to understand and appreciate the connections between people, their actions and the environment.

After your visit, use what you have learned and organize a Read to Feed program and raise money to buy an animal for a family in need. Read to Feed is a reading incentive service-learning program. Children get sponsors for each book they read during a period of time set by their leader. At the end of the program, the group pools its funds and donates them to Heifer. Teachers can customize a class fundraising webpage to track progress toward the goal, simplify the fundraising process and share students' achievements through social media.

### DAY PROGRAMS DISCOVER HEIFER

#### All Ages

### ANIMAL CONNECTIONS

#### All Ages

### OVERNIGHT PROGRAMS

#### GLOBAL GATEWAY

##### One- to Two-Night Program;

##### 6th Grade–College Age

Global Gateway creates an existence in which nothing—shelter, food, water or cooking fuel—can be taken for granted. Participants prepare a meal with limited resources and spend a night in the Global Village.



#### GLOBAL CHALLENGE

##### Two- to Three-Night

##### Program; 6th Grade and Up

Global Challenge pairs the Global Gateway experience with globally-themed teambuilding exercises that develop communication skills within your group while exploring Heifer's guiding principles.

#### ALTERNATIVE BREAK

##### Five-Night Program; 6th Grade–College Age

This program combines experiential learning programs, such as the Global Gateway experience and teambuilding, with service activities. The service allows participants to give back while experiencing something for the first time—like milking a goat or harvesting vegetables.
