When I was in Spitalfields market last year I spotted some beautiful embroidered dresses.

I stopped to talk to the lady selling them, and asked her how long it took to make them. She told me that hand embroidering takes over 100 hours per dress!

When I saw the price was £130 I thought that was quite low for such a unique item. That's a lot of work for much less than minimum wage.

That conversation made me realise that many of the high street retailers we support are pushing prices down, and making it difficult for independent makers to survive.

Most of the big brands outsource their production processes, setting up factories in third world countries where workers are exploited and basic human rights undermined.

We have heard horror stories about badly built factories falling down and crushing people to death, children being sent to work, and employees jumping from factory windows because they would rather die than endure those working conditions.

Bacanara taught herself to sew and learnt embroidery at a college in London. She has been in business for 12 years and dedicates almost every waking hour making dresses.
