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MENTOR Adult Day Health Announces Grand Opening of Horizons Memory Care in Brockton

BROCKTON, MASSACHUSETTS – MENTOR Adult Day Health is announcing the Grand Opening of Horizons Memory Care, a new adult day health center in Brockton specializing in services for adults with Alzheimer’s and dementia. The center is located at 55 City Hall Plaza in Brockton.

An official Open House event will be held on Thursday, November 7th, from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The event will feature a ribbon-cutting ceremony with Brockton Mayor Moises Rodrigues at 5:00 p.m., as well as refreshments and tours of the program’s features.

“Our innovative day program is a place where seniors can make friends, increase their independence and receive the daily living supports they need to thrive,” said Rob Buckel-Gillis, Program Director at the center. “Horizons Memory Care is a multicultural center serving Brockton and surrounding areas, and we are excited to offer high quality services to elders with a wide range of needs.”

MENTOR Adult Day Health currently operates 17 other adult day health centers in Massachusetts, including two centers in Brockton, South Shore Haitian Adult Day Health and Brockton Adult Day Health. These centers offer a continuum of services and supports for elders, including those with complex medical or rehabilitative needs.

MENTOR Adult Day Health staff work with each participant to create an individualized Plan of Care that fits their needs and interests. For one adult, this may mean help managing an illness such as diabetes; for another, it may mean social activities, help with medications, and meals tailored to their special dietary needs. Depending on each person’s unique needs, the care plan may include services such as nursing care, social activities, healthy meals, and transportation to and from their local center.

Horizons Memory Care will place particular emphasis on services for adults with Alzheimer’s, dementia, and other progressive memory disorders. Services offered at the program will include nursing and medical supports, assistance with daily living, case management, behavioral health services, and physical, occupational and speech therapy.
