Fiberglass poles are another very common option. These are inexpensive and have the same tactile strength as aluminum. But remorsefully, they are not very durable.

Steel poles are communal for 8-person camping tents. They are quite heavy, but they are strong and reliable too.

Climate And Seasons

If you are taking the best 8-person tent for a specific time and season, you pick accordingly. For example for cold weather camping, you need something warmer and strong. The pole material should not snap because of the cold as well.

1. Rei Co-Op Kingdom - Best 8 person waterproof tent

The Rei Co-op Kingdom is lightweight and easy to use for eight people. It does not have any rooms or compartments. However, there is a center partition to add some privacy in the camp. It has two doors for entrances. One of these is the vestibule to ensure the tent remains dry.

There are mesh windows for ventilation in this camp. The pole material of this tent is aluminum. The other fabrics vary to make it more efficient. For example, the rainfly material is 75-denier polyester taffeta to keep the water away. This material makes it the best 8-person waterproof tent.

Pros:

- Aluminum pole for sturdiness.
- Vestibule to keep it dry.
- One partition in the middle.
- · Mesh windows.
- Waterproof material.

Cons:

- Does not have compartments.
- Height is only 5 feet.

2. Coleman Montana - Best coleman 8 person tent

3. Eureka Copper Canyon- Best 8 person family tents

The standing height is about 7 feet so no one has to slouch. It comes with a divider curtain to make compartments. Each side has its own door for entrance.

To help keep the camp cool, the whole top is mesh and perfect for ventilation. This camp uses a 75D Storm shield polyester fly to protect you from the weather. It also makes the tent durable. There are plenty of small pockets around the camp to store small items safely.

Pros:

Cons:

- Needs an extra layer in case of rain.

4. Coleman Instant - Best 8 person instant tent

This instant tent does not compromise on quality at all. The material is a rugged poly guard with double thickness. It uses the WeatherTec system to weld the floors close tightly to keep the camp dry and comforting.

The height of this tent is 6 feet and 7 inches so almost everyone can enjoy without slouching. It comes with its bag which ensures the safety and makes it easy to carry around. The camp also has several storage bags.

Pros:

5. Ozark Trail Dome - Best 8 person 3 season tent

There are foldable divider and doors on both sides for entrance and exit. The mud mat keeps your feet clean when you come inside. To add portability, this camp comes in its own duffle bag. The weight is also light to help carry it easily. The height of this tent is about 6.3 inches and you can stand without slouching.

Pros:

- Tall center height.
- Mesh roof and windows.
- Rainfly to prevent rain and water.

- Two entrances with mud mats.
- Divider.

Cons:

Tricky setup.

6. Ozark Trail L-Shaped - Best cheap 8 person camping tents

The Ozark Trail L-shaped tent is another perfect type of eight-person camping tent on the market. This camp is L-shaped which gives you more facilities. The shape helps make two compartments for privacy yet togetherness. You can fit eight people easily in this camp. There is a pass-through window for more ventilation as you will find five windows in this tent.

To help make this portable, the camp comes in its own bag. It weighs very light and is easy to assemble. The height is about 6 feet and two inches to accommodate everyone. The setup is in about 15 minutes only.

Six windows and the mesh roof adds more ventilation and gives you a view. The center height is about 6 feet and 4 inches. To make it portable, you can store it in the duffle bag and carry it anywhere you like.

Pros:

Three rooms with foldable dividers.

- Long height.
- Mesh roof and 6 windows.
- Three entrances.

Con:

- Quite heavy.
- Setup takes a lot of time.
