Taj Mahal, India

Victoria Falls, Zambia/ Zimbabwe

The Local people refer to the falls as "Mosi-oa-Tunya", the smoke that thunders. The Victoria Falls are located in southern Africa on the Zambezi River border between Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Adrenaline junkies will enjoy thrilling activities such as white-water rafting, river boarding, jet boating, bungee jumping, abseiling, zip-lining, micro lighting above the falls.

Other activities to enjoy at the falls include helicopter flights overlooking the falls, safari drives, animal experiences and canoeing. The best time to visit the falls is in February and May, directly after the region's summer rains.

Bora Bora, French Polynesia

This tropical paradise is perfect for a romantic getaway from sandy blue beaches to luxury over-the-ocean bungalows.

There are many activities to explore, such as helicopter tours, kite surfing, Hiking, Snorkelling, jet skiing, parasailing, and scuba diving.

Bora Bora is, however, pricey. Resorts stays can cost anywhere from \$400 to \$1,500 per night, and a week-long trip could cost \$10,000 or more per person.

Rome, Italy

Discovered in 753 BC, the famous quote "Rome wasn't built in one day" indeed has a meaning to it. Italy's capital and largest city, Rome, is one of the most picturesque cities globally.
