

Stylin' Swifties: The Concert Couture of Taylor Swift's 2023 "Eras" Tour

Within the vast and colorful realm of the Swifty fandom, Taylor Swift devotees do not just attend shows as mere observers; they create impressive, unique outfits that recall Swift's album themes, becoming active participants of the concert spectacle. Those sexy, bejeweled bodysuits from designer Roberto Cavallo are all about the romance and heat of Swift's album, "Lover", so you'll see fans follow suit, festooned in sequins and dazzling jewelry. It's a fabulous spectacle of color and texture, and her adoring devotees are all in.

Online Swiftie fashion guides also offer fans tips on DIY outfits (from glitter and sequined miniskirts to prairie dresses) and footwear (sequined boots, glittery silver sandals, high-as-heck, bright pink platform boots, simple white sneakers, ballet flats, black creepers, leather country cowboy boots), and Taylor herself comes in all colors of the rainbow, her onstage outfits ranging from elegant flowing gowns taken from romance novel book covers to those dazzling, crystal-encrusted Cavallo body suits one would expect on a Vegas showgirl or a trapeze artist. It's obvious Taylor puts an enormous amount of thought and energy into every aspect of her sold-out shows, from musical numbers to texture and setting, and her fans love – I mean, *LOVE* – her for it.

Taylor Swift is truly an icon, and fans have taken over social media with their own unique creations and recreations of Swift's iconic outfits. Swifties have even created outfits based on bits of Swift's lyrics, and fans in the know all revel in discovering the Easter eggs found in each interpretive design revealed at each sold-out show.
