Light to Night: Invisible Cities 10-19 Jan | Civic District

Making its highly-anticipated return is the fourth edition of *Light to Night Festival: Invisible Cities*. Take a stroll along the Civic District and be mesmerised as the city lights up in a stunning display of visuals, sounds and movement.



Pop by The Arts House to catch renowned artist Yinka Shonibare's batik-inspired installation, *Justice for All* which pays homage to the rich heritage of Singapore's oldest colonial building.



Art Encounters by Lionel Sabatté 12 Jan-2 Feb | Orchard Road

Walk down Singapore's busiest shopping district and encounter art like never before. Art Encounters is set to unveil three shipping containers repurposed into a mobile art studio and gallery along the streets of Orchard Road. Watch contemporary French Artist Lionel Sabatté live-in-action as he creates three art sculptures over 6 days from 11 to 16 Jan, or catch his final works on display until 2 Feb.

Embark on an adventure to find the hidden gems and artworks located at Jalan Besar & Gillman Barracks.



TWENTY TWENTY | 10 Jan-Jun | 2 Cavan Road

Located within the hipster district of cafes and coffee joints in Jalan Besar, come and see a 20,000 square feet old industrial space transform into an eclectic pop-up of artworks and installations titled *Strange Things*. Headlined by Singaporean Artist Dawn Ng and hosted by The Lo & Behold group and ERCO, this collective endeavour tells of the unique stories and objects that have influenced the building's landscape.



Art after Dark | 17 Jan | Gillman Barracks

For the slightly more adventurous, enter into Singapore's contemporary arts enclave: Gillman Barracks. *Art after Dark* is the flagship event featuring a combination of stimulating visual art and electrifying music. As you gallery-hop between resident galleries featuring new exhibitions and programmes, be sure to check out the titular artworks of *Singapore Biennale 2019: Every Step in the Right Direction*, as well as *S.E.A Focus*, a regional art fair showcasing contemporary Southeast Asian art from leading local and international galleries.

ARTWALK Little India: Passage of Time 10-18 Jan | Little India & Jalan Besar

Embark on a journey through time and space and experience Little India through a series of curated art trails, site-performances, craft workshops and a theatrical dining experience with performances by LASALLE. Round off the night shopping for one-of-a-kind products at Little India's first artisanal market, So Cantai.



Atypical | 17-19 Jan | National Design Centre

Having travelled across the globe from Russia and India, to Myanmar and Thailand, *Atypical* makes a homecoming return to National Design Centre as part of Singapore's Art Week 2020. Held in collaboration with Chan + Hori Contemporary and Singapore Tourism Board, this exhibition uses AR technology to showcase seven local artists, the 'trailblazers' of Singapore's arts scene while bringing to life a new and interactive art experience.
