Undoubtedly, Excision hosts the two most prominent bass focused festivals out there. We have all been waiting for the official dates for both Bass Canyon and Lost Lands the moment they had ended. Well, it's time to put those requests off at work because they are here!

Bass Canyon will be returning to the Gorge Amphitheater from August 28th-30th, and Lost Lands will be back at Legend Valley this September 25th-27th 2020.

With its inaugural year in 2017, this marks the event's fourth year in the books. Lost Lands is a prehistoric paradise and is also referred to as the "Dubstep Disneyland". If you are a fan of that heavy-hitting aggressive bass, then you either: 1) have been to Lost Lands or 2) are dreaming of it.

There's an uncountable amount of reasons why Lost Lands is the best festival. There is no better bass music lineup anywhere. You will never have to worry about buying tickets before the lineup releases. Excision plays multiple sets throughout the weekend, one being a full two-hour set, and another one known as his "Detox" set. There will also be a crazy b2b set which we will find out when released. Last year was Excision b2b Illenium, and there were no words to describe it.

Lost Lands also gives the world's greatest bass music producers a platform to present their skills at full force. The sound quality is impeccable. Totalling over 1-million-watts of total sound, it became the largest ever deployment of PK Sound.

Under the prehistoric laser-lit skies, there are two main stages at Lost Lands. The Prehistoric Paradox and the Wompy Woods are accompanied by giant screens, life-size dinosaurs, and volcanoes spitting fire. After seeing your favorite producers and headliners at those stages, you can head to the sound camps where the party lives on. We can't imagine what Excision and his team have in store for us for Lost Lands 2020, but if there's anyone that can make a perfect festival even better, it's him.
