



Fellow nominees must:

- Be a member of the Society in good standing.
- Possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in terms of engineering experience.
- Have at least 20 years of experience in a manufacturing related area. Time spent in pursuit of a related academic degree may also be applied toward the 20-year requirement.
- Have a nomination initiator and two sponsors (the initiator and one sponsor must be Honorary, Fellow, Life or Senior members of SME.)

This annual honor is awarded to a number of outstanding young manufacturing engineers, **age 35 or younger**, for exceptional accomplishments, such as technical publications, patent or technical-professional society leadership.

Nominee eligibility:

- Outstanding Young Manufacturing Engineer nominees must be age 35 or younger on Aug. 1 of the year of their nomination.
- He/she may be a graduate or non-graduate, engineer or technologist, U.S. or international citizen.
- SME membership is not a requirement. Nominations must include a copy of the nominee's resume or CV.
