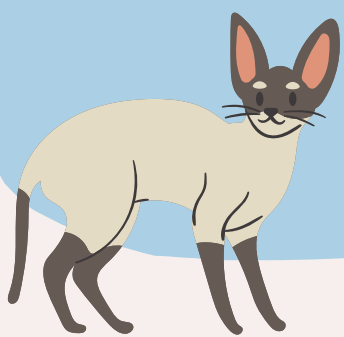


THE BENEFITS of SPAY & NEUTER

Spaying a female cat, especially before the first heat, helps prevent uterine infections, uterine cancers, and breast cancer.



Neutering male cats eliminates the chances of testicular cancer and lowers the risk of prostate problems



Spayed or neutered cats will be less likely to roam, yowl, wail, display aggressive behavior, or spray / mark their territory.



Roaming can also expose your cat to dangerous diseases, including feline leukemia and feline immunodeficiency virus.



Spaying and neutering can help control pet overpopulation and reduces the number of strays that end up in shelters
