



# Step 1




Tap the "Messages" icon  on the main screen.

# Step 2




Tap the "New conversation" icon .

# Step 3




In the "Recipient" box, enter your recipient's mobile number. Then, on the keyboard, press the "Next" key.

# Step 4




To add a recipient from "Contacts," start typing the contact's name. When the name displays, tap it.

# Step 6




Tap the "Send" button .



# Step 1




Tap the message icon  .
