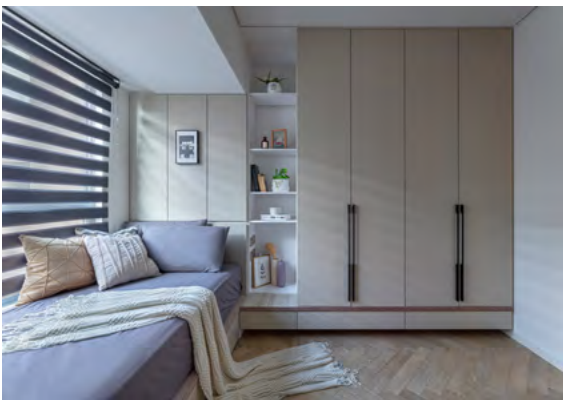




Origami



Taking inspiration from the idea of finding peace in a noisy world, the designer transformed an old home into a brand-new home with a charming look. Combining the clients' personality and preference with design, the designer added a fresh and simple style to the interior to minimize home decorations and encourage interaction in home.



Laying stress on natural lighting, the designer increased daylight penetration in home by transparentizing partition walls to decrease visual obstacles and visually enlarge spaces.



In the living room, the internal wall is replaced with glass partition wall to create semi-open place. The zigzag lines of shelves on partition wall visualize the imaginary of shape-shifting origami, which adds feeling of novelty to home and prevents the feeling of oppression caused by concrete walls.



For enlarging spaces, a wall in the kitchen is removed to install kitchen island bar. The large window on the beside wall allows daylight to penetrate through, which makes the home brighter and warmer.



In the master bedroom, the headboard wall injects mildness and harmony into the interior with the special wood grand texture. The exterior windows in bathrooms bring genial sunshine in, creating a relaxing and comfortable ambience. Besides, bathroom mirror cabinets improve functionality and increase space value.





By accurately measuring and adjusting, the designer found the ideal bearing capacity and designed light supporting structure, visually reducing the heaviness of metal materials and presenting the elegant and neat lines.
