All Northwestern Medicine Child Life Specialists possess a Bachelor's degree, with many holding a Master's degree. Our specialists' essential credentials include: (1) education in child development; (2) significant skill and experience in understanding and meeting the unique needs of children, teens, and families; (3) the completion of a clinical internship with a certified Child Life Specialist; and (4) passing the national certification exam.



Every day, our nine Child Life Specialists provide support tailored to each child's individual needs, on both an inpatient and outpatient basis. Through therapeutic play, music and art expressive activities, and procedural education, our specialists prepare children for medical tests and surgery.

Pediatric Care at Northwestern Medicine Central DuPage Hospital



Central DuPage Hospital (CDH) is the provider of choice for pediatric care in the Western Chicagoland area, serving approximately 1 in 3 pediatric cases in the region – nearly 60,000 children annually.

In fiscal year 2019, Central DuPage Hospital Child Life Specialists enabled 70 percent of pediatric patients to successfully complete diagnostic imaging procedures, such as MRI's and CT scans, without any form of sedation.

Notably, CDH is the first non-children's hospital – and only the ninth in the world – to receive ChildKind Certification, an elite distinction by ChildKind International for demonstrating institution-wide excellence in assessment, prevention, and treatment of children's pain.

They also help to manage patients' pain through non-pharmacological means; play an integral role in reducing trauma in children undergoing difficult medical procedures; address the needs of siblings; facilitate coping; and provide bereavement support. Collectively, all these efforts promote favorable outcomes, marked by reduced length of hospital stay and decreased sedation.



You Can Make a Difference

The Child Life Program at CDH

Our Child Life Specialists' services are truly essential to the health and well-being of many children and families. However, these services are not reimbursable by insurance. Philanthropy has played, and will continue to play, a vital role in the daily functioning and development of our Child Life Program.

The American Academy of Pediatrics recognizes Child Life programs as a quality benchmark of patient-focused and family-centered care, as well as an indicator of excellence.

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Each year, three of our nine Child Life Specialists' salaries are supported by philanthropy (a total of approximately \$210,000) — a generous investment that helps to insure both the near-term and the long-term strength and success of our pediatric program. As many other suburban pediatric programs limit or close programs, CDH will need to accommodate a steadily increasing number of pediatric patients.

In light of this growth, as well as limitations on large scale event fundraising for Child Life due to COVID-19, we respectfully ask that you consider providing crucial funding for Child Life salaries in the form of agenerous gift of \$100,000.
