# Parents upset about MBBS, BDS mop-up round

Say seat selection ‘chaotic,’ ‘unfair’ to meritorious students

**BENGALURU:** Many parents  
have cried foul at the mop-  
up round that concluded on  
Monday to fill vacant MBBS  
and BDS seats.

Students who had already  
been allotted medical seats  
in the second round were not  
allowed to take part in this  
round. But those who were  
allotted dental seats were al-  
lowed to try for medical seats.  
Parents of medical aspirants  
were upset that seats in bet-  
ter colleges were being given  
to students with lower ranks.

“My daughter got an all-  
India rank of around 78,000  
but she could not get a seat  
in MS Ramaiah Medical Col-  
lege. She got admission in a  
different college in the city  
but we would have preferred  
MS Ramaiah. Now they are  
giving away these seats to

students having ranks be-  
yond one lakh. How fair is it  
to meritorious students?” the  
parent asked.

A total of 757 medical and  
683 dental seats were avail-  
able for allotment in the mop-  
up round.

“If there were only a hand-

ful of seats left for the mop-  
up round, it would have been  
okay. But here, over 1,000  
seats were left. They should  
have conducted a third  
round,” another parent said.

The parents also demand-  
ed why the round was being  
conducted offline. “They

could have made a facility to  
conduct it online, as they did  
the other rounds. There is  
so much chaos here. It’s dif-  
ficult to even enter the gate,”  
a third parent said.

The Department of Medi-  
cal Education clarified that it  
was just following the rules.  
“It’s a policy decision of the  
Central government that  
whoever has already been al-  
lotted seats cannot take part  
in the mop-up round. We are  
just following that. Further,  
there is a Supreme Court rul-  
ing that says there can only be  
two rounds after which only  
a mop-up round can be con-  
ducted,” Dr S Sachidananda,  
director, medical education,  
explained.

Some parents are now con-  
sidering legal remedies and  
may approach the high court.

# Pre-university dept cautions officials about fake marks cards

**BENGALURU:** The Depart-  
ment of Pre-University Edu-  
cation (DPUE) has directed  
its officials to be on the  
lookout for fake marks cards  
from different state boards  
presented by students.

Every year, during the ad-  
mission season, there are sev-  
eral cases of students produc-  
ing fake marks cards of Class  
X and XII to obtain eligibility  
certificates or migration certi-  
ficates.

“Students who want to take  
admission in PU have to get an  
eligibility certificate from the  
DPUE. Many of them come

with Class X marks cards is-  
sued by examination boards  
of different states and they are  
not aware that these are fake  
and illegal,” said C Shikha, di-  
rector of the department.

Agencies that issue these  
fake documents target stu-  
dents who have failed SSLC  
and PU exams. They charge  
them between Rs 20,000 and  
Rs 30,000, make them take  
an examination and then give  
them fake certificates.

The department has a list  
of authorised boards of differ-  
ent states from the Council of  
Boards of School Education in  
India (COBSE) and they also  
have samples of their marks

cards. “We are now issuing a  
circular to the deputy directors  
in districts to follow certain  
steps for verification. They  
will be asked to refer marks  
cards from other states to us  
so that we can verify if they are  
authentic,” she said.

Last month, the depart-  
ment filed an FIR against one  
such agency in Hubballi which  
claimed to give Class XII equiv-  
alent certificate from the non-  
existent Karnataka Institute  
of Open Schooling, Hubballi.  
“In Karnataka, only DPUE is  
authorised to give Class XII  
state board marks cards. So,  
when the student came here  
asking for a migration certifi-

cate based on this marks card,  
we immediately knew it was  
a fake,” the director said. The  
department also came across  
a fake Class X marks card  
which claimed to be issued  
from Jammu and Kashmir.  
The officials will write to that  
state to inform them of this  
forgery.

Now, the department will  
issue a circular to all princi-  
pals of PU colleges to be on the  
lookout for fake documents.  
They will also issue a circular  
to alert parents and students  
to stay away from agents who  
promise them marks cards for  
a fee.

## Kalburgi murder probe in final stage: Siddaramaiah

**BENGALURU:** Investigation into  
the killing of rationalist Prof M  
M Kalburgi has reached its final  
leg and the case will be cracked  
soon, Chief Minister Siddara-  
maiah said on Monday.

Wednesday marks two years  
since Prof Kalburgi’s assassi-  
nation. A renowned scholar,  
Prof Kalburgi was 76 when two  
bike-borne miscreants shot him  
dead at his Dharwad home on  
August 30, 2015. He was shot in  
the chest and forehead at point-  
blank range. Prof Kalburgi’s  
assassination was preceded by  
the killing of rationalists Naren-  
dra Dabholkar (August 2013)  
and Govind Pansare (February  
2015), which are being probed  
by the Maharashtra police.

“It has been established that  
all the three killings are con-

“Investigation teams of both  
Karnataka and Maharashtra  
have found similarities in the  
killings,” he stated.

The chief minister, who also  
holds the Home portfolio, has  
directed the Criminal Investiga-  
tion Department team to work  
with its Maharashtra counter-  
part more closely. “Our probe  
team has reached its final stage  
in the investigation and I have  
asked officials to expedite the  
probe,” Siddaramaiah said.

# SC refuses to stop e-auction of iron ore in state

**NEW DELHI:** The sale of iron  
ore in Karnataka has been  
conducted in “the most out-  
rageous manner” in the past,  
which cannot be allowed to  
happen again, the Supreme  
Court said on Monday.

It rejected a petition by  
the lobby group, Federation  
of Indian Mineral Industries  
(FIMI), South, and Vedanta  
Ltd for scrapping the e-auction  
system for selling iron ore in  
Karnataka.

The Karnataka government,  
as well as the court-appointed  
Central Empowered Com-  
mittee, wanted to replace the  
e-auction by setting up a com-  
mittee of officials to monitor

the sale through e-platform by  
long-term agreements. NGO  
Samaj Pariwarta Samudaya  
has opposed the petition.

A three-judge bench led  
by Justice Ranjan Gogoi said:  
“The experience of the past  
has been horrific. It cannot be  
allowed to come back. (The)  
sale and purchase of iron ore  
had been conducted in the  
most outrageous manner and  
on wholly unacceptable terms,  
resulting, inter alia, in huge  
leakage of government reve-  
nue. Such experiences and  
events cannot be allowed to  
resurface.”

The court added that since  
a cap on production (30 mil-

lion metric tonnes) in Ballari,  
Chitradurga and Tumakuru  
districts, and restoration of  
ecology and the environment  
through a Comprehensive En-  
vironment Plan for the Min-  
ing Impact Zone (CEPMIZ)  
had been under consideration,  
the time was not ripe for the  
restoration of normal sale and  
purchase of iron ore.

“Taking an overall view  
of the matter, we are of the  
opinion that (the) time has  
not come to dispense with the  
existing policy of sale and pur-  
chase of iron ore in Karnataka  
through the court-appointed  
monitoring committee by e-  
auction put in place by an

order on September 2, 2011,”  
the bench, also comprising  
Justices Prafulla C Pant and  
Navin Sinha, said.

The court, however, ac-  
knowledgeed that any trading  
process had to be free and fair  
with liberty to the contracting  
parties to work out their own  
terms of sale and purchase.

“What cannot be ignored  
are the circumstances which  
had prompted the court to  
conceive of and continue with  
a departure from the normal  
rule, and instead to have a reg-  
ulated -if not highly controlled -  
system of sale and purchase of  
iron ore,” the bench said.

# ‘Allow CBZ grads to apply for teacher jobs’

**BENGALURU:** Leader of the  
Opposition in the Legisla-  
tive Assembly Jagadish Shet-  
tar on Monday accused the  
state government of flouting  
norms in the recruitment of  
10,000 higher primary school  
teachers by not allowing BSc  
Chemistry, Botany and Zool-  
ogy (CBZ) graduates to apply.

Only BSc Physics, Chemis-  
try and Mathematics (PCM)  
graduates are allowed to par-  
ticipate in the recruitment.  
“This is injustice to CBZ  
graduates,” Shettar stated in

a letter to Chief Minister Sid-  
daramaiah and Primary and  
Secondary Education Minister  
Tanveer Sait.

The decision to not allow  
CBZ graduates from partici-  
pating in the recruitment will  
affect 11,000 candidates who  
have cleared the Karnataka  
Teachers Eligibility Test, the  
former chief minister stated.

On August 24, the state  
government notified the re-  
cruitment of 4,233 teachers  
for mathematics and science  
subjects, 4,531 for English and

1,236 for social studies. Four  
recruitment examinations will  
be held in November.

Shettar demanded the noti-  
fication be withdrawn and CBZ  
graduates be allowed to apply  
for jobs.

According to National  
Council for Teacher Educa-  
tion norms, Shettar stated that  
science teachers must have  
studied any two subjects from  
chemistry, botany and zoology  
in the BSc degree. “The gov-  
ernment is violating this norm.  
Also, it is against the rules to

recruit one teacher to teach  
mathematics and science.”
