Curators manage collections of artwork and interpret them for the public.

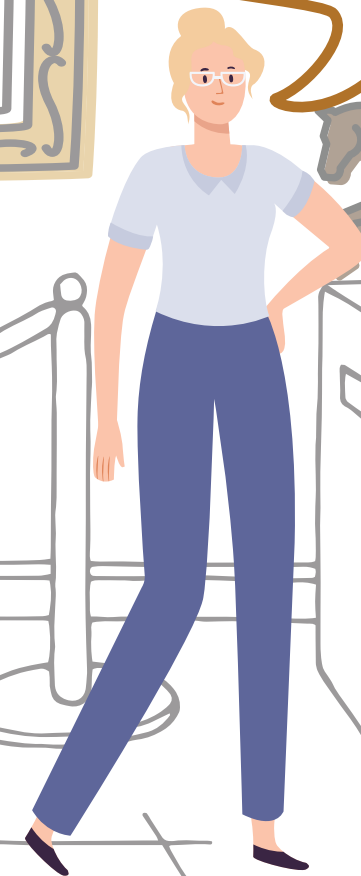
Fun Fact: The word "Curator" is borrowed from Latin and means "One who looks after" or "Guardian"
