Dior launches Dior Milly Dentelle collection

Dior has announced the launch of its new Dior Milly Dentelle collection, designed by creative director Victoire de Castellane.

The new range is inspired from Christian Dior's domain in Milly-la-Forêt, featuring a "dreamlike" landscape dappled with a profusion of flowers, foliage with asymmetrical curves and groves.

A pluralistic tribute to the heritage of Dior, the collection includes 76 pieces which are sublimated in white, yellow and pink gold – elaborated like a delicate thread of lace.

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Alternately set with stones and subtle pearls, they feature a palette of “luminous”, dazzling” hues.
