# PADI Advanced Open Water Certification in Komodo & Raja Ampat



The PADI Advanced Open Water Certification is the next best step for beginner divers looking to grow and expand their diving capabilities and underwater exploration. It comes after the PADI Open Water Course for all the tools you need to master new skills, dive down to deeper depths, become a better diver with better qualifications and feel safer and more confident while underwater.

Throughout the PADI Advanced Open Water Certification course, you'll practice navigation, buoyancy and deep diving and make three <u>speciality</u> dives of your choosing whether wreck diving, altitude, boat or digital underwater imaging and so much more. The course takes approximately 2-3 days & upon completion, you'll be qualified to dive down to depths of 30 metres as opposed to only 18 metres as an open water diver. ### **How To Obtain The PADI Advanced Open Water Certification?**

Divers who have completed their PADI Open Water often ask - what are the requirements for obtaining a PADI Advanced Open Water certification? To become an Advanced Open Water diver, all you need to do is <u>sign up</u> for the course with M Diving and let us know your preferred location – Komodo or Raja Ampat.

Throughout the course, you'll practice a number of underwater skills with our professional and experienced PADI instructor. After some skill practice with your instructor, you'll make five open water dives. There's no exam because this course is truly about having fun and gaining experience.

This course starts with an eLearning module which you can complete from anywhere at your own time before moving on to the next phase with your instructor. You'll plan your learning path with your instructor by choosing from a long list of Adventure Dives.

There are two required dives – Deep and Underwater Navigation – and you choose the other three, for a total of five dives. During the Deep Adventure Dive, you learn how to plan dives to deal with the physiological effects and challenges of deeper scuba diving. The Underwater Navigation Adventure Dive refines your compass navigation skills and helps you better navigate using kick-cycles, visual landmarks and time.

The other knowledge and skills you get vary with your interest and the adventures you have – photography, buoyancy control, fish identification, drift dives and many more. You may be able to get college credit for the Advanced Open Water Diver course.

Beyond using basic scuba equipment, you'll need a compass and dive knife or dive tool. You'll also use specialised gear depending on the Adventure Dives you choose.

Raja Ampat is home to the highest concentration of incredible marine and coral reef biodiversity in the world - over 550 different species of corals, 700 types of molluscs and over 1600 species of reef fish, all in the most beautiful and pristine turquoise water you'll ever see. Over 75% of the world's marine species are found here. You could even spot several different shark species, sea stars, eels, sea turtles, manta rays, schooling fish and reef-building corals. If you're lucky you might even spot whales and dugongs.
