

Yes. Rest assure, it's happening:)



"Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper." (Psalms 1:1-3)

Be watchful, there's a plethora of voices out there telling ppl they're saved in order to keep the Torah. This is not the way of righteousness, but straight confusion and double-mindedness and Abba is not the author of confusion. The law that we keep now, is the law of faith; the faith of Jesus; the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus:

"For Christ is the end of the law for <u>righteousness</u> to every one that believeth. For Moses describeth the righteousness which is of the law, that the man which doeth those things shall live by them." (Romans 10:4-5)

No cherry-picking which Mosaic Law [<-click to learn who the Law is made for] you fancy. You want to keep one or some of them, you gotta bear them all. However, the goodness of God, is His Son Jesus!!! Did you know the last command the Father gave, was not via Moses? God the Father spoke it Himself, well, two times and of course it's all about His beloved Son. First, at His Son's baptism, when Jesus fulfilled all righteousness and secondly, more clearly at the mount of transfiguration. Here's what Abba both testified and commanded:

"While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him**." (Matthew 17:5)

God Almighty commanded the disciples to literally <u>hear, listen and keep His Son</u> — not the mosaic law or the prophets anymore. When Peter, John and James beheld Jesus transfigured before them, they saw the Son of God's face shining like the sun, and His clothing white as the light. And there appeared Moses and Elijah both talking with Him. 'Moses' representing the law, 'Elijah', the prophets— which led us to our Savior: the Messiah, Yahusha Jesus Christ of Nazareth: the Root of Jesse, an ensign for the nations and the restorer who is assembling the outcasts of Israel and gathering the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth: the remnant of His people. He says:

"I am the vine, ye are the branches: <u>He that abideth in me</u>, <u>and I in him</u>, the same bringeth forth <u>much fruit</u>: for without me ye can do nothing...(John 15:5,7-10)

If we abide in Christ and His words abide in us, we shall ask whatever we will, and it shall be done for us. In this is our Father glorified, that we bear much fruit; so shall we be His disciples. This is where patience is everything. Many are working...but w/o love: w/o the Son of God. Now, as the Father has loved His Son, so has Christ loved us: so we are to continue in His love. This Incorruptible Seed produces after its kind; which is the righteousness we need in order to exceed the Pharisees' of our day. If we keep His commandments, we'll abide in Christ's love; even as Christ kept His Father's commandments and abides in His Father's love.

"The <u>fruit of the righteous is a tree of life</u>; and he that winneth souls is wise." (Proverbs 11:30)

The Messiah desired that His disciples believe on Him: our faith doesn't save us — it's His faith that saved us. So, what were they to believe about Him? That He came and died on a tree, and was buried and on the third day raised from the dead? Doesn't just about everyone believe or know that? Ask an atheist, a mystic, a satanist, a buddhist, a hindu, a muslim, even new agers know of the Son of God but lack understanding. So couldn't anyone *parrot* the Word and say, 'Jesus is Lord' or 'Jesus is the Son of God' but have missed the true reality of what they're actually saying? Well, here's the simple truth the Lord planted in me back in 2020:

"For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God. I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father. His disciples said unto him, Lo, now speakest thou plainly, and speakest no proverb. Now are we sure that thou knowest all things, and needest not that any man should ask thee: by this we believe that thou camest forth from God. Jesus answered them, Do ye now believe?" (John 16:27-31)

Clearly this is the moment that marked their belief. His disciples truly understood what it meant to believe the Lord Jesus: 'Now we are sure You are the Messiah, the divine Son of God, who literally came out from God. You know everything!' In their joy, they confessed this revelatory foundational truth of the Gospel.

"Jesus knew that the Father had delivered all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was returning to God." (John 13:3)

"Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me." (John 8:42)

These verses confirm the truth Jesus desires for us all to understand about Him, so that we may receive this glorious gift of God. He truly desires all to believe His origin and family descent is strait from the only true living God, the Father: bc eternal life is in Him! Here the disciples-turn-apostles believed w their heart unto righteousness and w their mouth confession was made unto salvation. Pls go meditate on John 16:25-33.

Directly after this, Jesus went strait into prayer w the Father. In John 17, specifically verse 8, Jesus' prayer confirmed this: "For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me."

There it is! We can't do any righteousness, unless we first believe and receive Him who is righteous! :)

"But now **the righteousness of God** <u>WITHOUT THE LAW</u> **is manifested**, being witnessed by the law and the prophets." (Romans 3:20)

Remember the mount of transfiguration? Where the disciples beheld Moses (who signified the mosaic law) and Elijah (who signified the prophets) talking w Jesus? — or 'witnessing the righteousness of God'?

"Even <u>the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ</u> unto all and <u>upon all them that believe</u>: for there is no difference: for all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:21-23)

So, when Jesus told His disciples that He literally came forth from the Father and His Father sent Him into this world, His disciples discerned something v special — which I also perceived as well and I hope you do too. In this beautiful scene, our Messiah spoke to His disciples w/o using a parable or a proverb. He just spoke w them like true friends confide in one another...I mean, seriously, what an honor!

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that <u>heareth my word</u> [the living Word], and <u>believeth on him</u> [the only true living God, Yahuah] that sent me, <u>hath everlasting life</u>, and shall not come into condemnation; **but is passed from death unto life**." (John 5:24)

In 2020, the Lord opened my eyes re: the YouVersion app, revealing the ecumenical persuasion that was on the horizon. They had just rolled out *YouVersion Prayer: 'Honest conversations with God, in community'*. It sounded nice but after I put two and two together, I was compelled to seek the Lord for assurance and solid evidence that a) I believed the truth that saves and b) abode in the faith of Jesus. Considering at that time my network was a gumbo of a variety of believers in Christ: I did not want to be naive of what a false witness is.

So, fearing God, I prayed asking what did the disciple/apostles actually believe about Jesus? I initially was led to the Book of John. As I studied, I noted everything I could find. Beginning in John 2:22, I found my 1st clue: it was written, His disciples '...believed the Scriptures and the word which Jesus had said...'. There it is, the root to the formula of genuine belief in the Most High Yah and Yahusha Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

I believe the Scriptures are the inspired Word of God, and His Son who graciously opens our understanding:

"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." (1 Timothy 3:16-17)

This infallible living Word reveals the Spirit of prophecy: which is our Heavenly Father, the Most High Yah Himself, witnessing and prophesying about His beloved Son since the beginning—and now thru us. What has Abba Father told us about His Son? What is the record God gave of His Son, that is forever settled in Heaven? For it is written: God gave us eternal life and this life is in His Son. I pray the Lord has opened your eyes and you gladly receive Him, bc if you don't believe in your heart that He is the divine Son of God, you will die in your sins. Abba testified to this, His Son testified to this, the apostles and the prophets testified to this and, there are a few of us today who boldly testify and believe on the Son of God, bearing the witness of God in ourselves — this testimony of Jesus is w/in the whole Family of God, in heaven and on earth.

"Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified <u>in</u> Christ Jesus, called to be <u>saints</u>, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both their's and our's: Grace be unto you, and peace, <u>from God our Father</u>, and <u>from the Lord Jesus Christ</u>. I thank my God always on your behalf, for <u>the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ</u>; That in every thing ye are enriched <u>by him</u>, <u>in all utterance</u>, and <u>in all knowledge</u>. <u>Even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you</u>: So that ye come behind in no gift [i.e. by bearing the greatest gift, eternal life, the love of God indwells our flesh thru our Lord Jesus who gives each of us spiritual gift(s) for building us up]; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who <u>shall also confirm you unto the end</u>, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. **God is faithful**, <u>by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord</u>." (1 Corinthians 1:2-9)

So set to your seal God is true. We are to be adamant, as we were warned that <u>many deceivers</u> have gone out into the world that confess not that Jesus Christ <u>is come</u> in the flesh: as it is written, salvation <u>is come</u> unto the Gentiles, in Romans 11:11. John wrote in present-tense, stating the most concise, most definitive confession of salvation, in its most simplest form. Bc the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life <u>through</u> our Lord Jesus Christ—Christ life indwelling His disciples. This is how we know God dwells in

us and we dwell in God, by the Spirit which He has given us (1 John 3:23-34). Bc we are adopted sons and daughters, God has sent forth **the Spirit of His Son** into our hearts crying Abba Father.

For by [the grace of God] we are saved through [the faith of Jesus], and that is not of ourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast — as no flesh should glory in His presence, that according as it is written, anyone that glories, let them glory <u>in</u> the Lord: hidden in Christ, abiding in <u>His living Word</u>.
