HEARD THIS MORNING AS I AWOKE: "REVERENCE MY NAME...THE NAME OF THE LORD."

"God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, <u>hath in these last days spoken</u> <u>unto us by his Son</u>, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high:" (Hebrews1:1-3)

"Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that <u>the name of God</u> and <u>his doctrine</u> be not blasphemed. And they that have believing masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort. <u>If any man teach otherwise</u>, and <u>consent</u> <u>not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ</u>, and <u>to the doctrine which is according to godliness</u>; he is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself. - 1. <u>be of little strength</u> (mortify the deeds of the flesh <u>by the Spirit;</u> meek, real lowly of heart; faithful; for the righteousness of God, is by faith of Jesus Christ our Lord, unto all and upon all them that believe He is who He says He is: the Son of God)
- 2. <u>keep His word of patience</u> (in quietness and confidence shall be our strength; strengthened w might in our inner man; glorying in our weaknesses that His power will rest upon us; standing strong in the Lord and in the power of His might)
- 3. <u>not deny His name</u> (confessing and understanding His name, not only deflecting to the Greek meanings behind His name to justify your deeds but honoring the simple fact that humanity can actually <u>call on the LORD now</u> and be saved all bc of His beloved Son, whom He sent, who laid His life down and received it again for us, to the glory of God, His Father).

Our Lord interceded for us too, and His prayer is as solid as a rock. There are so many gems w in this passage (John 17), that I pray we can catch them all, w understanding. I find it is best when I go to my personal Bible and read the scriptures out loud, slowly to myself. Even repeating some verses, just to make sure my understanding is open and attentive to His voice — and His voice alone. Enjoy.

"These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said,

Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and *I am glorified in them*. And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are. While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled. And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves. I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them."

## 😍 ALLELUIA [usually pronounced as] "HAL-LE-LU-YAH" 🥶

~ 'hallel' meaning 'praise' and 'Jah' (pronounced as 'Yah') meaning 'the LORD/God' ~

Below I use the Hebraic names of Abba Father (יְהוָשׁׁן) and the Lord Jesus (יְהוּשׁע) to try and illustrate why *"all men* should honor the Son, even as they honor the Father. He that honors not the Son honors not the Father which has sent Him. Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that <u>hears My word, and believes on Him that sent Me</u>, has everlasting life and shall not come into condemnation but is passed from death unto life." (John 5:23-24) "Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also." (1 John 2:23)

So let us hear our Lord's word, "...I came out from God." (<u>John 16:25-31</u> <—hear it) but when the fullness of the time was come, God <u>sent</u> forth His Son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons, and because we are sons, <u>God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son</u> into our hearts crying Abba Father. (Note: God did not send 'a third person of a trinity' or 'a third manifestation of himself'). If you really love Jesus, <u>hear His word</u> <— believe Him and <u>receive the living Word of God</u> in your heart.

reverence יָרָא - to revere, be afraid; to fear; be afraid to stand in awe of; be awed to fear; to inspire reverence, honour, respect

- he that fears the word of Yah/the name of Yah: Yahusha is the Word made flesh who manifested His Father's name
- to cause astonishment/awe of Yah Himself: Yahusha glorified Yahuah, His Father (the LORD God Almighty) on earth
- Translation: 'YAH' means 'the LORD' + 'YASHA' means 'saves'; 'delivers'; 'gives victory' = 'YAHUSHA' in English: 'JESUS'
- Seeing the meaning of Jesus name in Hebrew really helped me understand why its commanded to be baptized in His name
- "For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ." (Gal 3:27) "If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory." (Col 3:1-4) "Saying with a loud voice, <u>Fear God</u>, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: <u>and worship him</u> that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters."
