

ournal Entry - Mon July 3rd (dream) 'Had a dream this morning where EVERYONE in it, believed the doctrine of the trinity. I mean, everyone did. I began to think... okay?!! Well where in the Word is it, that's making ppl believe and confess this? I pondered, is this really in the Bible? And I heard or had a v clear thought: Isaiah 14. It was as if, there is where I will find it. Bc it seemed everyone believed in a third person, in relation to the Godhead... or that the Godhead is an unit divided, having persons w in it. Strange.

I made a mental note: to look this up when I awake. I didn't want to forget. So upon waking, I immediately go straight to Isaiah 14, w anticipation, to see if I could understand what the hype was all about re: this estranged doctrine and speech. Stunned, flipping to the page, I saw that it was about Lucifer and how he fell, due to his prideful, envious, selfish, desires to be LIKE Yahuah Most High. Mm, no, only Yahusha (Jesus) is like His Father, bc He literally came out from God; Jesus came forth from His Father, validating why He is the only begotten divine Son of God.' [journal entry ends]

Side note: my husband made a v insightful, yet albeit, innocent observation one afternoon mid last month. We were having one of those rare phone convos, discussing the Garden of Eden. I asked, 'how many beings were in the Garden?' He whimsically answered, 'two!' So I think I followed up w something along the lines of, 'then... why do ppl think God created 'three persons' in His image and after His likeness?' He paused there for a min. Then after a few seconds, he blurted out, 'Wait! There was a 'third person' or a 'third being' in the Garden...' I said, 'who!?' He said, 'the serpent!' I was speechless.

I think he thought he was being cheeky — he does have quite the sense of humor. But of course, I didn't take him lightly. I pondered it and brought it before Abba in prayer. Then, fast fwd a few wks later, I get this dream w specific instructions in it, pointing me to Isaiah 14. A coincidence? We know God doesn't call many that are wise but he calls the foolish to shame the wise — could Abba Father, the only true and living God of Israel, have given this to my husband?

"For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But <u>God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise</u>; and <u>God hath chosen the world to confound the things which are mighty</u>; And <u>base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not</u>, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence. But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: that, according as it is written, he that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord." (1 Corinthians 1:26-31)

Now just so you have a little context, my husband grew up baptist. He also went to a catholic grade school. So all he knows is what is taught in those places: trinities; co-eternal gods working together as one; one means three but wait, three means one, only in religion. They say, 'the God of Israel, is co-eternal w 2 other persons: 'god the son' and 'god the holy spirit', making them a triune godhead'. Bt that doesn't sound v peculiar or set-apart from the rest of the world's false Babylonian triune (god)desses, to me. Christendom has likened the Almighty God of heaven and earth, to the gods of Babylon: using similar speech, titles, phrases, philosophy and vain deceit according to the tradition of men and the rudiments of the world, and not Christ.

So, br Paul warns,

"If any man teach otherwise and <u>consent not to wholesome words</u>, <u>even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ</u>, <u>and to the doctrine</u> which is according to godliness; <u>he is proud</u>, <u>knowing nothing</u> but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh <u>envy</u>, <u>strife</u>, <u>railings</u>, <u>evil surmisings</u>, <u>perverse disputings of men of</u> <u>corrupt minds</u>, and <u>destitute of the Truth</u>, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself." (1 Timothy 6:3-5).

So now rooted and grounded upon this solid Rock, in Love, I stand upon a sure foundation. I never had a clue Abba desired me, or would call me by name, or that I was His and belonged to Him. Faithfully, He intervened the mess I was, and diligently cleansed me of the miry clay. Taking my hand, He befriended me. Hand in hand, I returned to Abba Father, receiving remission (or forgiveness) of my sins thru the death of His Son, my King, my true Friend, my Ruler's everlasting name. Now I rest, hidden, abiding in Christ, filled w my Savior's holy authored and finished Life. Jesus Christ is come in my flesh and the only One who dwells in my heart by faith. He is the narrow Way, the Truth that saves; that sanctifies, and the righteous Life His Heavenly Father promised to pour out upon all who truly believe His Son's witness, w all their heart. So, set to your seal that God is true, today. Abba gave His witness about His Son first, and Their testimony is forever settled in heaven.

"If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son. <u>He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself</u>: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son. <u>And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son</u>. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you <u>that believe on the name of the Son of God</u>; that ye may know that <u>ye have eternal life</u>, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God." (1 John 5:9-13).

When I believed on Jesus, as Lord, I believed He is the Christ, the divine Son of God, and abased myself. Abba granted me repentance and I <u>died</u>, submitting to my Lord, being baptized in His everlasting name, washing away my sins: I '<u>Reverence His Name</u>'. On July 29, 2018, I was buried w Christ in baptism, where I was also risen w Him thru the faith of the operation of God, who raised His Son from the dead. I was dead in my sins prior — the uncircumcision of my flesh, yet God <u>quickened me (He made me alive) together w</u> <u>Christ</u>, having forgiven me all my trespasses. Blotting out all the handwriting of ordinances that was against me, which was contrary to me. He took it out of the way, nailing it to His Son's cross at Calvary (ref. Col 2).

"Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:3-11)

So in quietness, I trust confidently in my Messiah's strength and wisdom and counsel, to diligently seek my husband, who is also His servant as well. I know my husband hasn't forgotten God's commandments, his memory is excellent. So as br Peter, on the Day of Pentecost, brought the men of Judaea into remembrance of how God exalted His Son to be Lord and Christ, *they heard* these things concerning the Kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ *and they understood*, and were pricked in the heart w the fear of God, also now revering His beloved Son as well. And w reverence for Jesus Christ their Lord, they desperately cried out, men, brethren *what shall we <u>do</u>?!* I'm v hopeful this shall soon come to past, according to God's perfect will, for my beloved husband as well.

"Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is to you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. And with many other [sound and wholesome] words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this crooked generation. Then they that GLADLY RECEIVED HIS WORD were BAPTIZED: and the SAME DAY there were added unto them about three thousand souls." (Acts 2:38-41).

"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He that BELIEVETH AND IS BAPTIZED shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." (Mark 16:15-16)

"And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, AND AROSE, AND WAS BAPTIZED." (Acts 9:17-18)

"And one Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good report of all the Jews which dwelt there, came unto me, and stood, and said unto me, Brother Saul, receive thy sight. And the same hour I looked up upon him. And he said, The God of our fathers hath chosen thee, that thou shouldest know his will, and see that Just One, and shouldest hear the voice of his mouth. For thou shalt be his witness unto all men of what thou hast seen and heard. And NOW WHY TARRIEST THOU? ARISE, AND BE BAPTIZED, and WASH AWAY THY SINS, CALLING ON THE NAME of the Lord." (Acts 22:12-16)

"In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to MY GOSPEL." (Rom 2:16)

"Now to him that is of power to stablish you ACCORDING TO MY GOSPEL, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to THE REVELATION OF THE MYSTERY, which was kept secret since the world began, BUT NOW is made MANIFEST, and by THE SCRIPTURES OF THE PROPHETS, according to the COMMANDMENT OF THE EVERLASTING GOD, <u>made known to all nations for the obedience of faith</u>: TO GOD ONLY WISE, BE GLORY <u>THROUGH</u> JESUS CHRIST FOREVER. Amen." (Romans 16:25-27)
