

The Perfect Eyebrows using Microblading

Have you ever looked at someone, man or woman and noticed how perfect their eyebrows are? They are full, perfectly shaped and symmetrical to their face. Well, there is a technique used to enhance your eyebrows or even give someone eyebrows who may not have any called Microblading. Microblading is a form of semi-permanent make up. Although the process may sound and look torturous, it is not invasive at all and in 3 hours or less, you too can have the perfect brows.

The first step in getting the perfect brows is to determine the shape you want. This is probably the most crucial step and the most time-consuming. Once your skin is cleansed with an alcohol pad, your brow artist will map out an outline of the shape that best fits your face. During this step, you want to make sure every line is as straight as possible and that you are happy with it. Remember, once the ink goes in, there is no turning back.

Once you are happy with the shape, at this point numbing cream is applied. This is so you can tolerate the procedure with minimal to no pain. You will need to leave this on for 20 minutes. It is important to not keep the numbing cream on longer than the recommended time because this will only cause irritation to the skin and the pigment/ink will not penetrate the skin properly. Once the 20 minutes is complete, the numbing cream is carefully removed. It is especially important to be careful not to remove the shaping outline that was done in the first step.

Now that you have the perfect shape and the numbing is complete, the artist will place pigment on the tip of a blade and place it into the skin creating hair strokes. The process is done in 2-3 passes, which means, the artist will do strokes, then switch to the other brow. They will

not completely do one brow at a time. More numbing is also done in-between each pass to make sure you stay comfortable.

At the end of the microblading process, your brow artist will remeasure to make sure the brows are even and as symmetrical as possible. The brows are cleansed, and it is time for the big reveal. This is the most electrifying part of the process. Once you are able to contain yourself from all the excitement of having full brows, pictures are taken and after care instructions are given. In most cases, you will need to do a touchup in 4-8 weeks. After that, your new semi-permanent brows should last you at least 1-2 years depending on your skin type. Follow your aftercare instructions closely to avoid infection and enjoy those beautiful new brows.
