- Bank accounts, investment accounts, and credit card companies
- The Department of Motor Vehicles and car insurance companies
- Cell phone providers, health and life insurance providers, and other regular bills
- The U.S. Postal Service
- Voting registry

✓ Update your budget and future expense plans.

Make sure you know what expenses are coming up, including:

- Homeowners' Association fees
- Escrow balance, property taxes, and homeowner's insurance
- Plan for any home repairs or renovations if necessary

✓ Cancel and review your homeowner's insurance.
