1. **Best Overall Rap Vocal Microphone:** AKG C214 Large-Diaphragm Condenser Microphone

Specs:

- Type: Large-Diaphragm Condenser
- Polar-pattern: Cardioid
- Self-Noise: 13dB (A weighted)

The AKG is a great fit for mouth-on-mic action and is resistant to plosives so it allows rappers to bring the energy without concern for losing quality.

It packs a punch without needing a whole lot of EQ, making life easier for you, production, and BOH. This mic's sensitivity showcases vocal texture perfectly.

Being bright and raw, it is an especially excellent fit for lower tones or male rap vocals. It highlights the nuances of voice so that both fast rapping and carefully articulated cadences are delivered well.

Although considered one of the best rap mics on the market, it is only \$399 from most distributors. Since it competes with mics that sell at \$1000, it is a great choice.

2. **Best Rap Vocal Microphone for Budget:** Rhode NT1-A Large-Diaphragm Condenser Microphone

Specs:

- Type: Pressure Gradient Condenser
- Polar-pattern: Cardioid
- Self-Noise: 5dB (A weighted)

The Rhode NT1-A Large-Diaphragm Condenser Microphone, like the AKG C214, it has versatility. This product lands at \$199, so if you're a budget shopper hoping to find a mic that'll produce pure, nuanced vocals, this is it.

This highly sensitive mic is a great option for rappers who want a warm, smooth, clear sound. In the studio, it's great because of its super low self-noise. Vocals can cut right through without having to mess around with static.

Not only is it a good mic for recording, it is one of the more durable ones. Since it's made of premium all-metal quality, it handles great on the road and can last a long time.

You won't go wrong with your purchase if you focus on the type of mic, directionality, sound quality, and price.

Type of Microphone

Condenser mics are more sensitive than dynamic mics so they tend to be more effective for picking up details and voice character. They're also typically a bit sharper and more "raw."

Directionality

Because cardioid mics are unidirectional, they are most responsive to the angle they are forward-facing. They are good up close which means rappers can be a bit more aggressive with the mic without it being overly perceptive to background noise.

Sound Quality

Sound quality is comprised of a number of interconnected factors including frequency response, self-noise, sensitivity, and maximum SPL. Each component should be taken into consideration based on user needs.

Price

Rap vocal microphones can range from under \$100 to well over \$3000. For an artist that wants a professional quality mic without breaking the bank, the market median falls around the \$199 price, the same as the Rhode NT1-A: great quality for the price.
