The Model: Earn and Learn

Students will not have to choose between going to college or going to work. Saint Joe Indy students will pursue their degrees and careers simultaneously.

- Curriculum built in conjunction with business/industry, particularly with Indiana's major industries of construction, IT, healthcare, and manufacturing
- Associate degrees in business administration coupled with in-demand workforce certifications
- Degree completion time in 22 uninterrupted months while earning a living wage through college-identified jobs and internships
- Students work 15-24 hours each week with employers/industry leaders partnering with Saint Joe Indy
