HAKE House of Art is a new gallery space located in Dee Why in Sydney's Northern Beaches on Guringai Land. A multidisciplinary creative space, Hake is a place where art comes to life and is breathed into our community.

Founded in 2022 by Ash Holmes and Jake Elliott, the gallery becomes a site to foster creativity, comprising of regular art exhibitions from both emerged and emerging artists and the invitation of independent projects.

For projects ranging from exhibitions, photography space hire, and events, HAKE supports an aesthetic vision that reflects a minimal philosophy. Our in-house residences offer services within; art consulting, canvas stretching + framing, photography, and videography.

HAKE works with artists who feel a sense of connection to their surroundings, an appreciation for nature, and understand the importance of working on Indigenous land. We want our artists to feel supported when taking risks with their original artworks and allowing HAKE to be the vessel for their work to be held.

HAKE aesthetic reflects Japanese notes to recognise their craft culture, which sees the value in the handmade and appreciation for items ageing well over time — to only make small quantities of handmade items with the intention that they will last a lifetime. We invite our artists and artworks to have the same meaning.
