14. Courtney Love



13. Amber Rose



The two first met when Federline auditioned to be one of her backup dancers. During an interview with Us Weekly, the now dad of six reflected on his marriage and divorce to one of the world's biggest superstars: "I came to LA, and two weeks later I was on the road with Britney for, like, two months. We met, and I'll tell you one thing – I never thought any of this would happen." Shortly after their first encounter, Kevin Federline famously married then subsequently divorced Spears, and fathered her two children during their time together. "That time of my life, it was great," the former backup dancer told Us. "It was fun, it was crazy, it was chaos... The limelight, the entertainment business, the lifestyle — period. When you're 25 years old, how do you handle that? Nobody can prepare you." 




Before they met, Sandler's wife Jackie Sandler, was working as a model and was admittedly a huge fan of his. The Hollywood actor met his future wife, Jaqueline Titone, when he was filming the movie *Big Daddy*. At the time, the beautiful actress was still trying to build her career from scratch. Jackie was a budding actress that had been cast in a small role as the waitress who takes Sandler's order of a root beer in a sports bar. The pair hit it off on set and started dating shortly after the film was released. She is an unrepentant self-proclaimed groupie who has just published a memoir, *The Last Living Sl*t: Born in Iran, Bred Backstage* which chronicles her wild escapades with members of the most illustrious (and not-so-illustrious) rock acts of the past three decades. *The Last Living Sl*t* is described as "the salaciously literary and s*xually liberated account of one young woman's transition from a traditionally-raised Iranian to a rock and roll groupie for Guns N' Roses, Motley Crew, and many others." After her family fled Iran for a dismal existence in London, Roxana escaped through the music and particularly the music videos of Guns N' Roses, which kickstarted her famous groupie phase. The events described in this memoir make Roxana one of the most popular and wildest groupies of the modern generation.

4. Bebe Buell





Imagine having Mick Jagger serenade you from a street corner or jetting off to Europe with Steven Tyler. That's the life Bebe Buell lived during the '70s, as girlfriend and muse to some of the biggest stars in rock and roll. Buell came to New York in 1972, with a contract from a prestigious uptown modelling agency. She found work as a model and was Playboy's Miss November in 1974, but she found her true home downtown mixing with rockers at cutting-edge music clubs like CBGB's. Bebe became a full-fledged member of LA's groupie scene, and had a brief relationship with Steven Tyler, which led to the birth of their daughter, actress Liv Tyler. Buell also hooked up with a number of other 70s stars including Elvis Costello, Todd Rundgren, Rod Stewart, and Duran Duran bassist John Taylor. She later recorded music of her own, and wrote a memoir about her days as a groupie. Bebe said of her former groupie days, "What a lucky girl I am to know so many wonderful, exciting, brilliant people. They represent different changes and different phases of my growth."

3. Nancy Spungen

Nancy Spungen is commonly revited in the same way Yoko Ono and Courtney Love are revited. All three are blamed for the downfall of beloved musical groups and were hated by their lovers' fans and bandmates. But before she became "Nancy" of the infamous "Sid and Nancy," Nancy Spungen was just your average groupie following bands like the New York Dolls, Aerosmith, and the Ramones around the world. Nancy gained international fame when she hooked up with Sex Pistols bassist, Sid Vicious, after Sex Pistols bandmate, Johnny Rotten, turned her down. Their year and a half long relationship became instant tabloid mania thanks to their public fights, crippling drug addiction, and brutal violence perpetrated against one another. Her volatile romance with Sid met an untimely end that would make rock and roll history, when in October 1978, Spungen's body was found in her room at the Chelsea Hotel. Sid was arrested for second-degree murder after her wound was traced to a knife that he owned. Sid made bail, but he died four months later of an overdose. Legs McNeil said, "Nancy had one of those passions for rock and roll that very few people have. She knew everything about every album. Groupies in those days were different. They were a part of the scene."

2. Pamela Des Barres

Pamela Des Barres is the kind of groupie that legends are made of, which is exactly why the character Penny Lane in the hit movie Almost Famous was based on her. She is most often remembered for hooking up with Mick Jagger, Jimmy Page, Keith Moon, Waylon Jennings, and a bunch of other rock gods in between. Des Barres carved out her place in rock and roll history as one of LA's most prolific groupies during an era when the members of Led Zeppelin rode motorcycles down hotel hallways and musicians got crazy rich off of record sales. But she also made music herself, as a member of The GTOs (Girls Together Outrageously), a band made up of a bunch of groupies organized by Frank Zappa. In pictures from the era, Des Barres is an ethereal glowing redhead, and exactly the kind of girl you'd want to spend time with if you were a virile young rock star in town for the week. Pamela became a celebrity known for getting with celebrities, and shortly after Kate Hudson portrayed her on the big screen, she wrote a groundbreaking best seller based on her experiences called: I'm with the Band: Confessions of a Groupie.

1. Jerry Hall

Jerry Hall is a model and actress that has been known for dating three very famous Mr. Rights — two rock stars and now one of the most powerful businessmen in the world, Rupert Murdoch. In 1978, 21-year-old Jerry's entire world changed when she was asked to pose as a mermaid for an album cover. "They picked me up at the airport," Hall recalls in her biography, "And that's when I saw Bryan. He was tall and handsome, with slicked-back hair." Bryan was Bryan Ferry, front-man of the famed band Roxy Music. She and Ferry were together for two years after Hall appeared on the cover of his album Siren. Hall's choice for her next great romance did little to dispel her groupie notion, as she began dating Mick Jagger while she was still with Ferry. "Amazingly, we never got caught," she said. "I was about to get married, but Mick just had this charm, and I was really crazy about him." This affair resulted in Hall's long-term relationship with Mick Jagger, with whom she had four children. Life with a Rolling Stone and now a future with Rupert Murdoch, a man said to be worth \$11 billion dollars, wasn't even imaginable for a girl who grew up poor in the middle of nowhere in Texas. But sometimes a groupie's dreams really do come true.
