It was clear that this programme would allow me to connect with individuals who can help me not only identify funding opportunities, but best position myself to secure them. As a young entrepreneur, there's a lot to learn – the Hatchery sounded like the ideal place to fill in those gaps in my knowledge.

The opportunity

The Hatchery programme gave me in the ins and outs of business. It has really useful sessions where I could look at my business from a clear lens and decide what I want it to be. It pushed me to think about areas of business I normally wouldn't think about, and I got to speak to experienced mentors from the world of finance, marketing, intellectual property and more.
