Everything will depend on what you want or your budget, but you can easily get a 4-star hotel for 2 people starting from \$80 USD per night

In general, Cabarete is an accessible destination for backpackers (Low \$), travelers (Average \$), or tourist (High \$) even for people coming from the Dominican Republic city, Santo Domingo. So, it will all depend on what budget you'd like to set for this trip.
