What is the Foxy Eye Makeup Look?

It's a makeup technique that has gained great popularity on social media in recent years, particularly on Instagram and TikTok. It involves strategically applying shadows and eyeliner to lengthen the eyes, like the almond shape of foxes.

Steps to Create the Foxy Eye Makeup Look

These steps will help you easily create a Fox Eye Makeup:

1. Apply a transition eyeshadow

The first step is to apply an eye primer, which helps the shadows stick better while making them last longer. It's recommended to use brown tones, **such as the Morphe 35O Nature Glow** or the ColourPop Going Coconuts. Now, with a blending brush, take a light brown shadow or one matching your skin tone and apply it all over the eyelid.

Next, **apply dark brown shadow with gentle taps**, focusing on the outer corner. Slightly extend it towards the temples for the elongated effect. To make your eyes pop, use a fine brush to apply a darker brown line, like eyeliner, and blend it into the crease.

2. Use a shimmery eyeshadow

Once you've added depth to the eyes with brown tones, it's time to brighten certain areas to make your eye look more attractive. Take a shimmery

eyeshadow **in a pearl or gold shade** and apply it with your finger to the center of the eyelid.

Also, **apply it to the inner corner** of the eye to brighten the eyes.

3. Apply eyeliner

This product is key to the Fox Eye Makeup because it defines and lifts the eyes. First, **use a felt-tip eyeliner** with a fine point to draw a thin line along your upper eyelid, following its natural shape. To finish, create a thin wing angled towards the temples.

To soften the effect, **blend the eyeliner with the brown shadow**. If you want to make it bolder, line the inner waterline to enhance the lifting effect.

4. Use mascara or lashes

To further enhance the shape of your eyes and capture attention, it's best to apply a coat of mascara. For a more dramatic effect, apply **false eyelashes with longer hairs on the outer edge**. However, if you prefer a more natural effect, it's recommended to just curl your lashes and add mascara to complete the eye look.

Don't forget to apply **makeup to your eyebrows** by brushing them with a brow spoolie and filling in sparse areas with brow shadow or pencil to add greater definition to your face.

5. Refine the eyeliner with concealer

To ensure everything looks perfect, take a fine brush with a bit of concealer that matches your skin tone or is slightly lighter. Next, **use it to clean up the edges of the eyeliner**—this will refine the look and correct any imperfections for a more flawless finish.

Don't forget to **carefully blend the concealer** with a dampened sponge. After that, you can apply foundation, concealer, contour, blush, and lipstick to complete the look.
