you start on your journey!

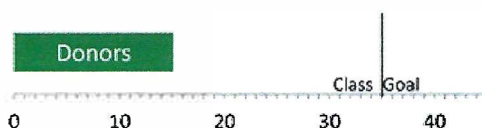
